You now have a beautiful kitchen scarf that can be looped through an oven handle or drawer pull. There are 15 different fun kitchen and food sayings that will bring a smile to your face every time you look at them. We are also including instructions on how you can create your own towel scarves from scratch.

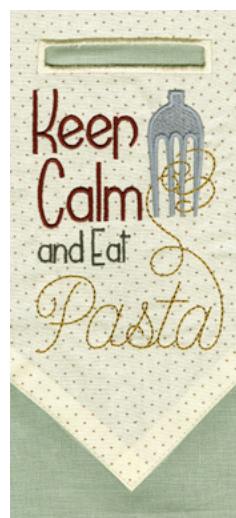
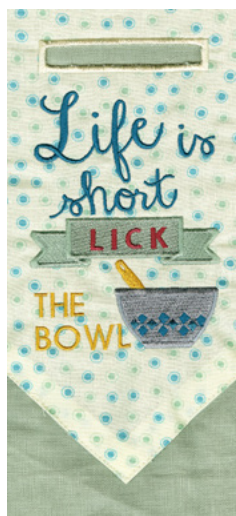
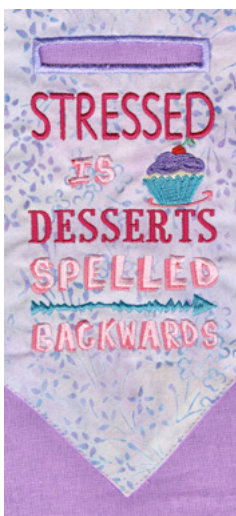
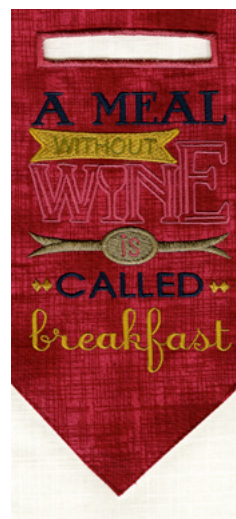
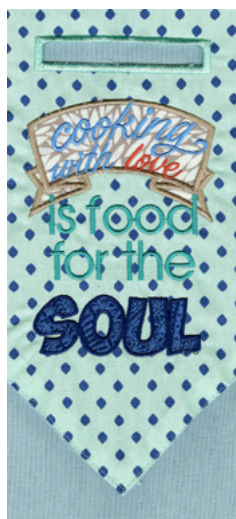
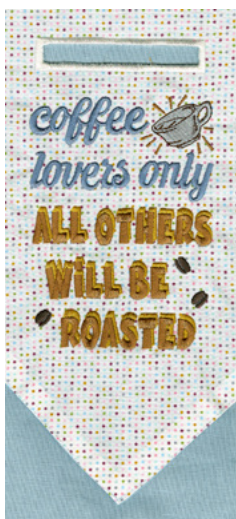
These designs come with easy placement stitches letting you know exactly where to place your Towel Scarf so that they sew out perfectly every time!

Isolated designs

We loved these phrases and sayings so much we thought it wouldn't be fair to just limit them to the towel scarves we designed them for. So, we created separate design files that isolate the phrases allowing you to stitch them on anything you like, such as aprons, reusable grocery totes, and more!



TOWEL SCARF DESIGNS



MATERIALS LIST

Towel Scarf

- ▶ Towel fabric 27" wide x 36" long
- ▶ Accent fabric 27" wide x 16" long
- ▶ Tear-away stabilizer
- ▶ Appliqué fabric (sizes vary see design pages)
- ▶ Embroidery thread to coordinate with design
- ▶ 1 spool all-purpose sewing thread

In Your Sewing Room

- ▶ Embroidery machine, power cord, and foot pedal
- ▶ Embroidery hoop
- ▶ Projects CD & USB stick
- ▶ Sewing machine feet: embroidery foot, regular sewing foot

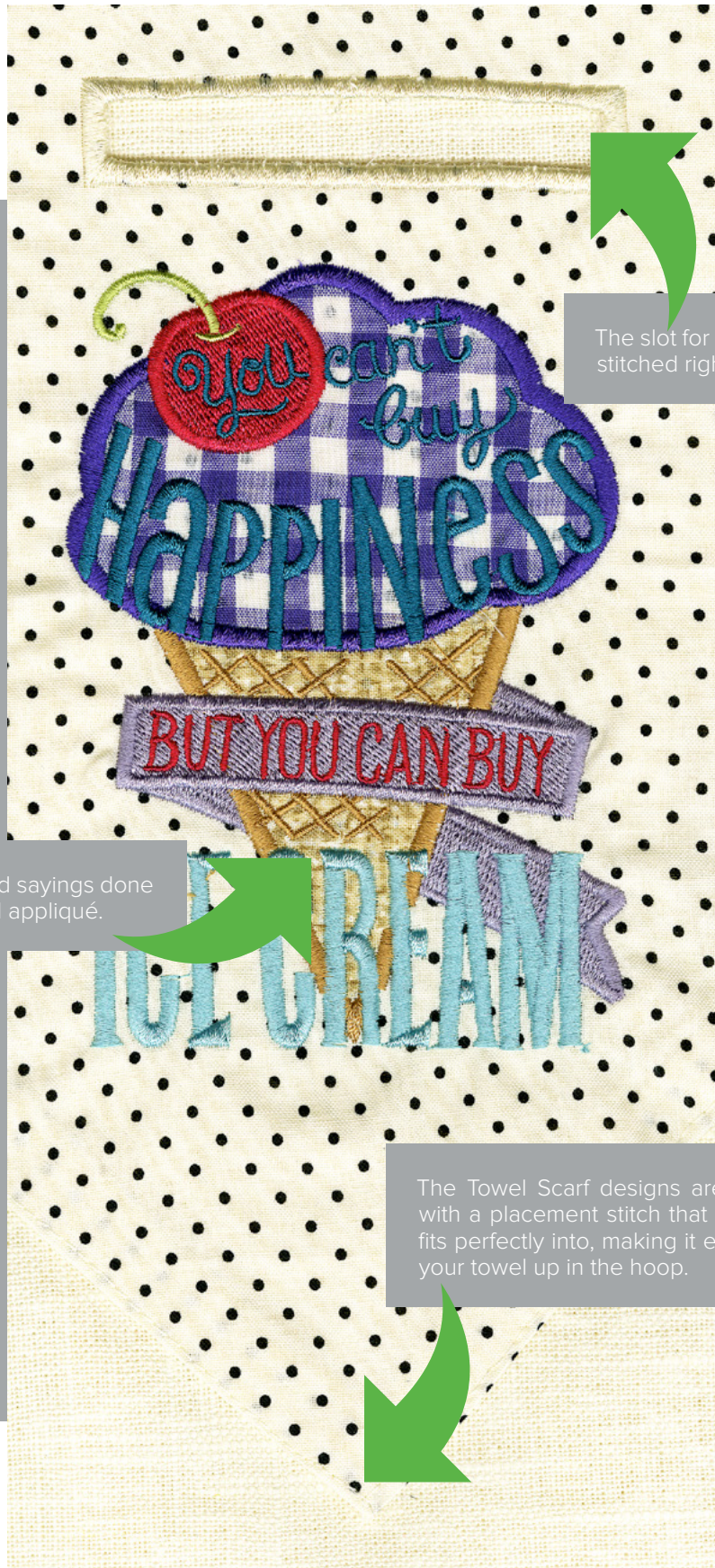
Notions

- ▶ Scissors
- ▶ Ruler
- ▶ Rotary cutter & mat
- ▶ Tape
- ▶ Embroidery needle, size 75/11
- ▶ Universal needle, size 80/12

Since this collection has many files with different sizes of appliqué, we cannot provide the exact amounts needed above. The easiest way to measure your fabric before stitching any one of these designs is to measure the placement stitches as you go, and cut accordingly.



ANATOMY OF THE DESIGN



The slot for your towel to fold through is stitched right in the hoop!

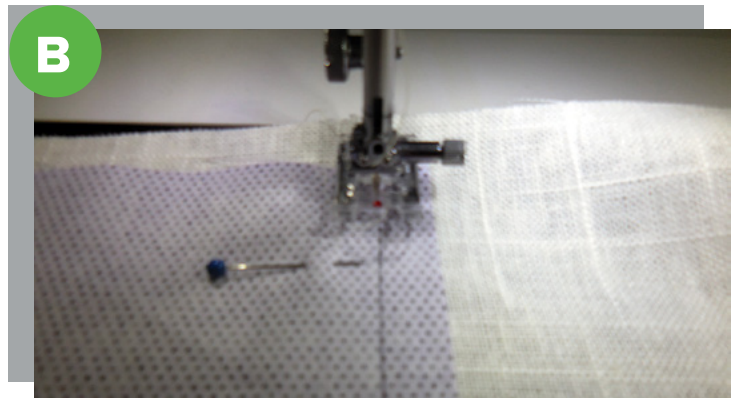
Beautiful designs and sayings done with embroidery and appliqué.

The Towel Scarf designs are digitized with a placement stitch that the corner fits perfectly into, making it easy to line your towel up in the hoop.

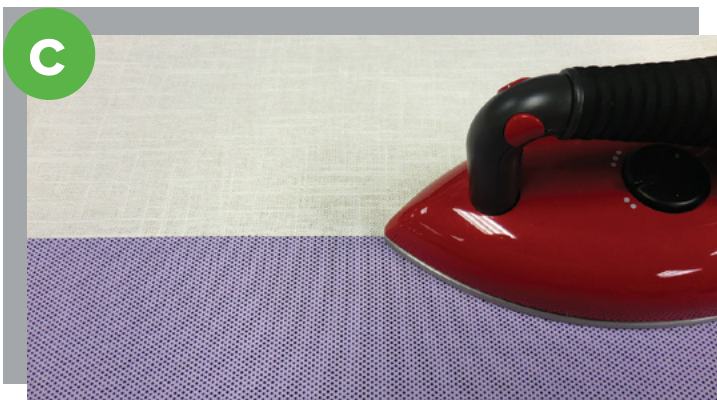
STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS



Place accent fabric on wrong side of towel fabric, right-side facing down, 15 ½" from the bottom edge.

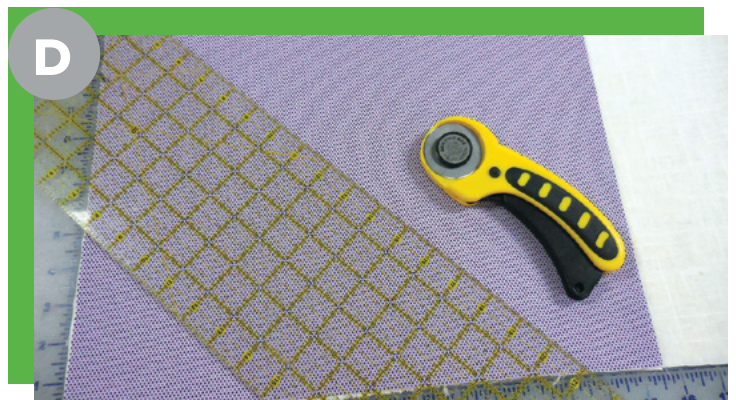


Sew the accent fabric to the towel fabric using a ½" seam allowance.



Fold the accent fabric down and press your seam.

Note: The bottom edge of the towel and the bottom edge of accent fabric should align.



Fold the towel in half longways. Place your ruler a ½" from the folded corner and 13" down along the raw edge. Trim the towel to create a point.

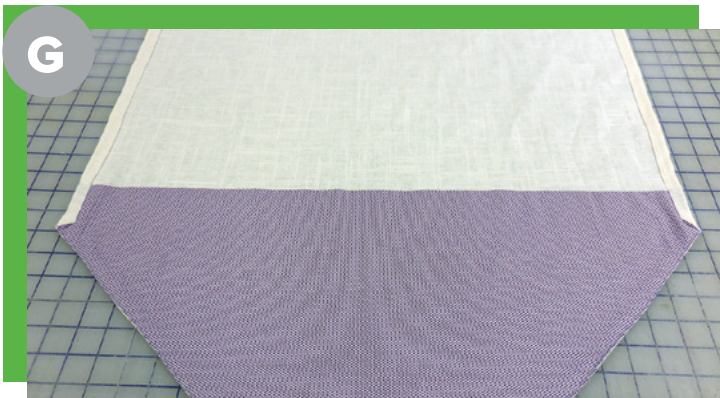


Once it's trimmed we are going to hem it. Use a ¼" double fold. Hem along the sides and top. Fold the towel edge and accent fabric edge under a ½" and pin in place.

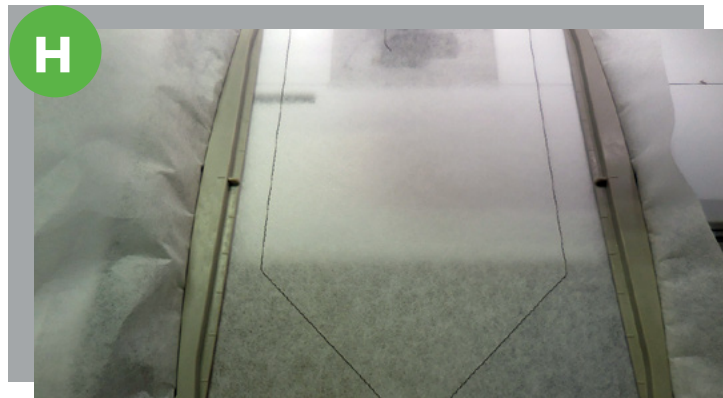


Top stitch ¼" from the edge.

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS



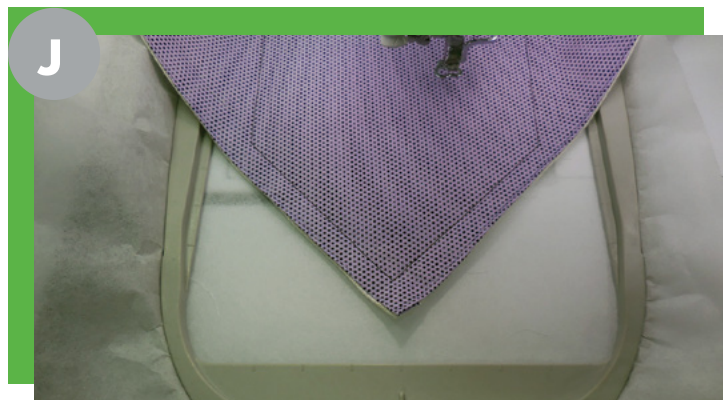
Your hemmed towel should look like this, we are now ready to embroider our design.



To start, hoop a piece of tear-away stabilizer and stitch step 1 of the design. This is the placement stitch.

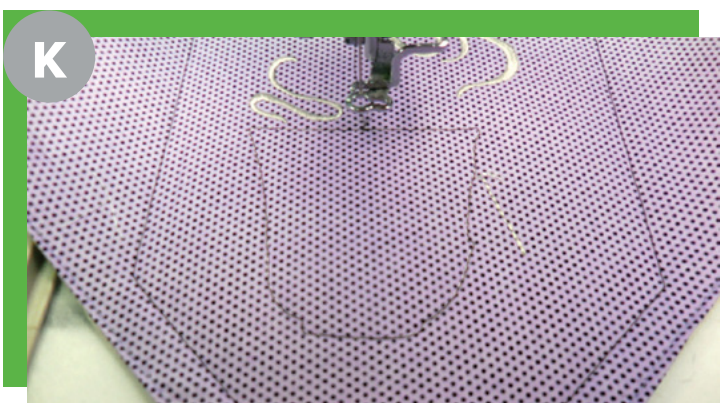


Line up the point of the towel scarf with the point of the placement stitch.

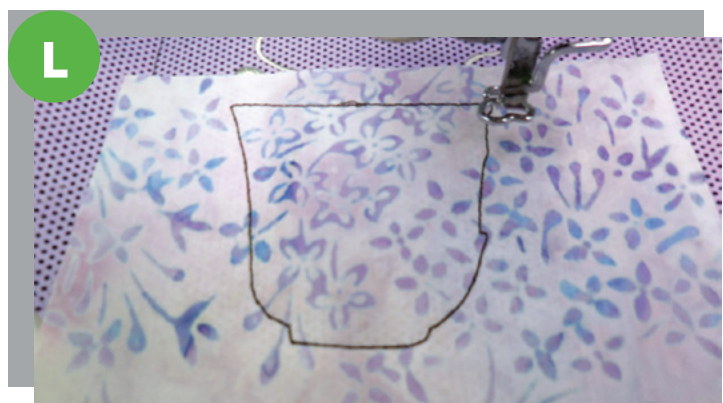


Step 2 will be the basting stitch to hold the towel in place for the embroidery stitches.

Note: The entire design will be inside of the basting stitch.



Continue with the embroidery steps until the first piece of appliqué. The first step for appliqué is always the placement stitch.



Lay the appliqué fabric over the top of the placement stitches, completely covering all sides. Then, stitch the tack down stitch.

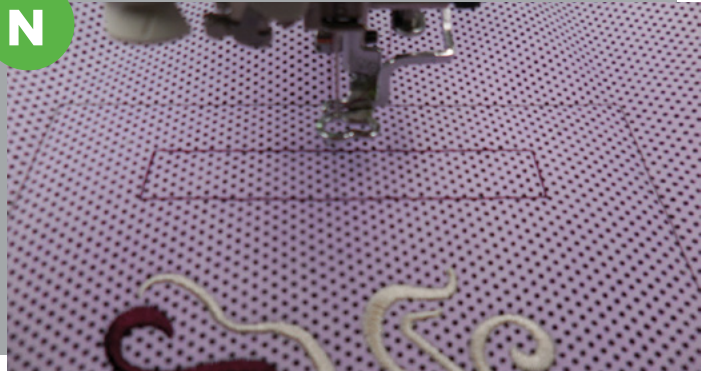
STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

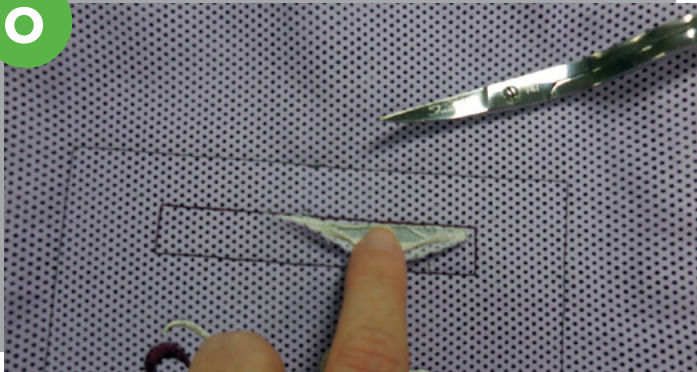
After the appliqué is tacked down, trim the excess fabric. A satin stitch will cover the raw edges of the appliqué piece.

Continue with the embroidery steps. The second to the last step will be the marking stitch for the towel scarf opening.

O



Trim the towel fabric and accent fabric from inside the marking stitch. Trim the excess fabric as close to the marking stitches as possible, *but do not cut through the stabilizer*.

Here is what the design will look like - the excess towel and fabric has been trimmed away, but the stabilizer is still in place to support the final satin stitch.

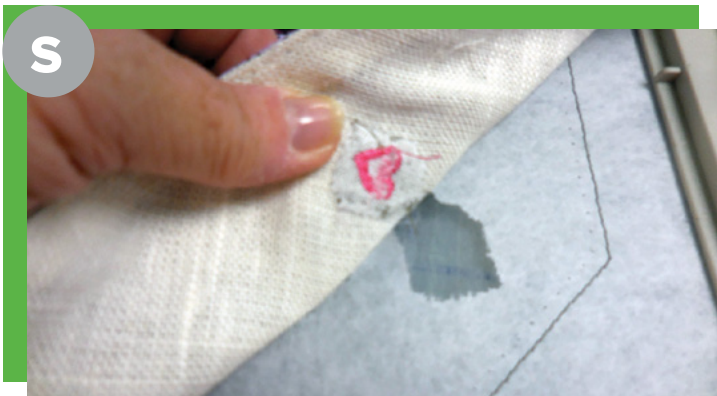
Stitch the satin stitch for the towel scarf opening.

R



Using a seam ripper, carefully remove the basting stitch from the towel scarf.

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS



Carefully tear away the design from the stabilizer.



Tear away the stabilizer from the towel scarf opening.



Gather the ends of the towel scarf.



Pull the ends through the handle of the desired towel scarf hanging location.



Pull the end of the towel scarf through the towel scarf opening.



Continue to pull the towel scarf ends through the opening until it is securely hanging in the desired location with your design facing outward.

15. Marking stitch - trim inside after this step
16. 672 - satin stitch for scarf opening
