### ICONOLOGY

There are 15 different embroidery techniques demonstrated in this book. We decided to code up with a new way to show you what technique a design is a technique. We chose to use 15 different colors that represent the 15 different techniques. We have this key under each design collection so you can easily identify what technique is being used. But also you can use these colors to create your own designs. But all of the letters in the key of the book have their own little tips to support for a collection for letters or for techniques.

Legend of the color-coded embroidery techniques explained:

The symbols above stand for the icons but will not be used for each collection. The icons which are highlighted denote the techniques used in a quilt-size collection. The other icons will be used indicating that those techniques are not used.

### APPLIQUE

The use of fabric instead of thread is a unique & useful approach. There are a lot of reasons for one approach in a design. The first reason is that using fabric instead of thread is a unique way. ## TECHNIQUES

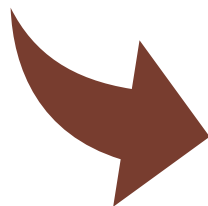


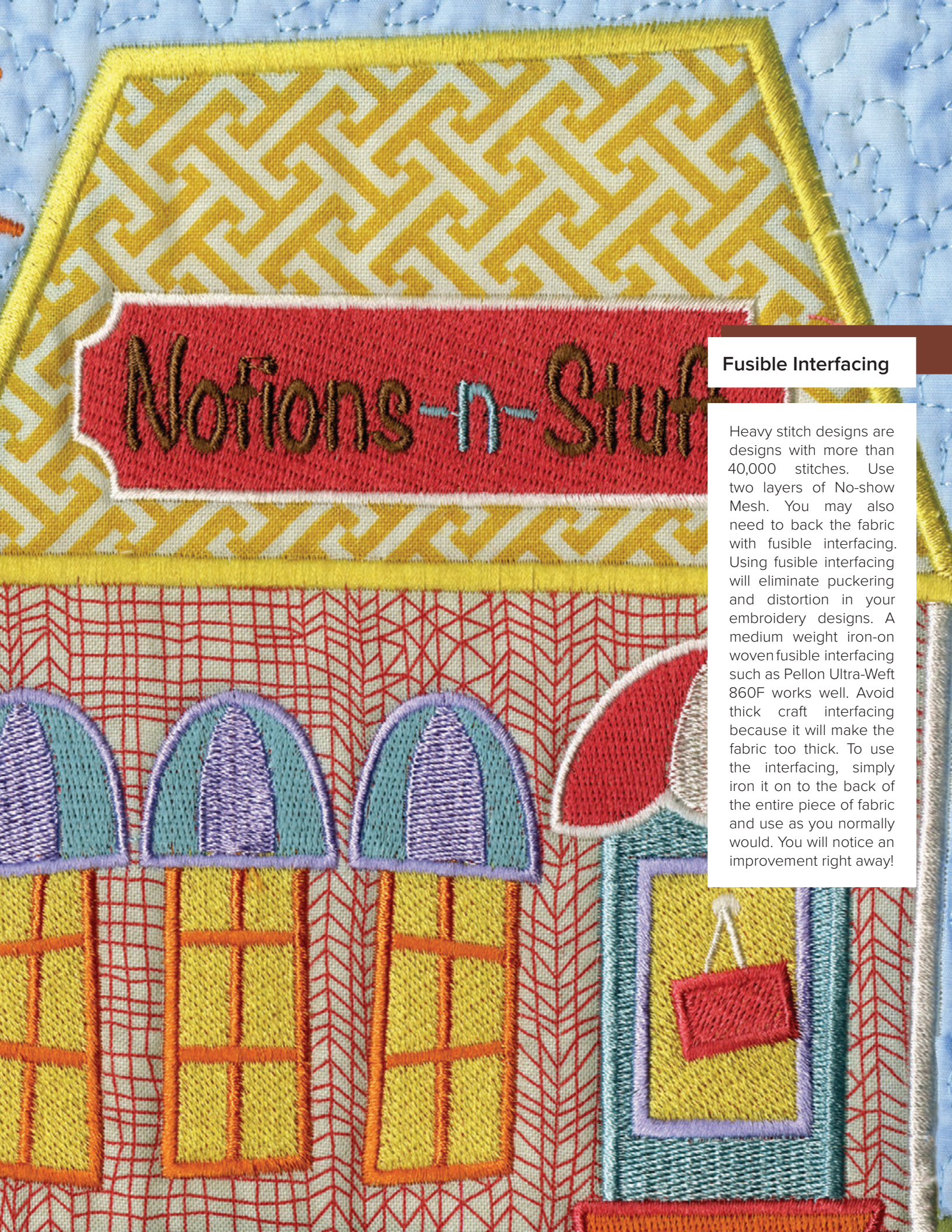
### Working with Appliqué

The great thing about appliqué is that it covers an area of the quilt block which, in the end, reduces the stitch count. With a lower stitch count, it also takes less time to complete the design. Throughout this collection we used multiple appliqués in every main block. Choose any color appliqué fabrics to give your quilt a unique and fun look!

### The Landscape Technique

With this collection, we used the landscape technique. The great thing about this technique is that you use two pieces of base fabric to distinguish the sky and ground from each other. There is a satin stitch, shown by the arrow below, that covers where the two pieces of fabric meet to give it a nice clean finish. Once you've stitched out a few of these blocks, you'll see how the rolling hills in the background all begin and end at the same point on the left and right of each block. This means that when you stitch them all together, it will look like one continuous landscape!

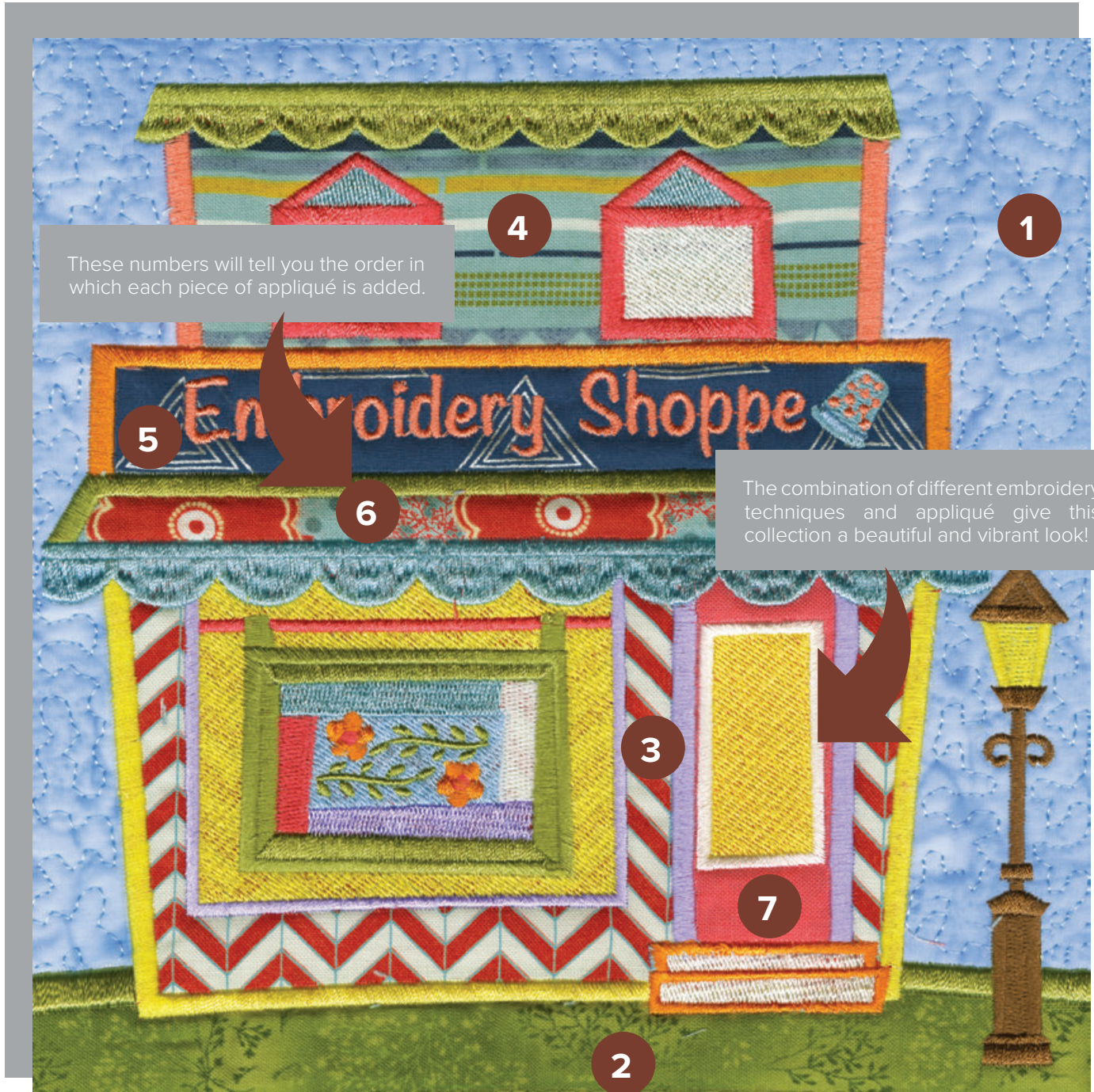




## Fusible Interfacing

Heavy stitch designs are designs with more than 40,000 stitches. Use two layers of No-show Mesh. You may also need to back the fabric with fusible interfacing. Using fusible interfacing will eliminate puckering and distortion in your embroidery designs. A medium weight iron-on woven fusible interfacing such as Pellon Ultra-Weft 860F works well. Avoid thick craft interfacing because it will make the fabric too thick. To use the interfacing, simply iron it on to the back of the entire piece of fabric and use as you normally would. You will notice an improvement right away!

## ANATOMY OF THE DESIGN



We created this tutorial to make your project as simple as possible. Our “paint by numbers” style of instructions will allow you to navigate through all the steps of each quilt block effortlessly. As you can see above, we have a photograph of a finished block with numbers on each piece of appliqué. These numbers will correspond with the instructions under

“Steps” on the design pages, letting you know the order in which each piece of appliqué is added. We suggest gathering all of your appliqué fabrics and laying them out in order to make sure you like the combination of colors before picking your threads or getting started. As always we recommend looking over each project thoroughly before beginning.

## COMBINING COLLECTIONS

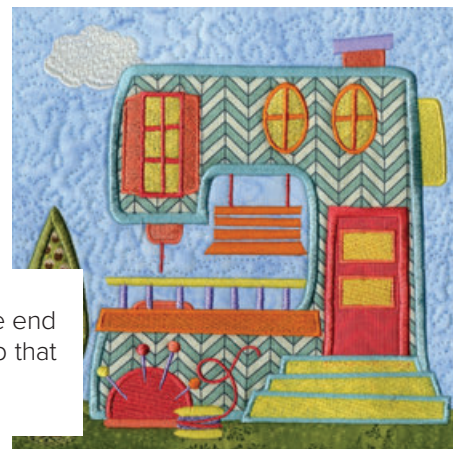

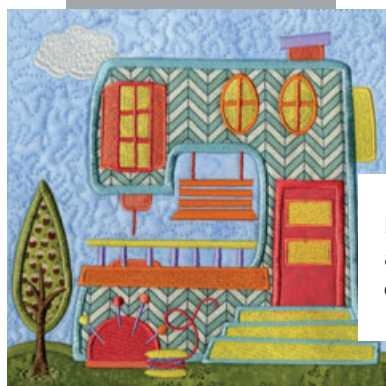
# DESIGN SIZE GUIDE



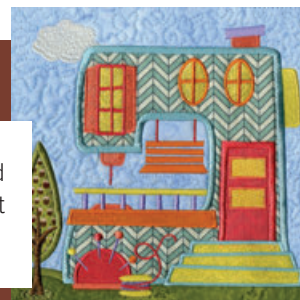
Designs with the letter **“AA”** at the end are the largest designs for a hoop that can embroider at least 9” x 9”.



Designs with the letter **“A”** at the end are the large designs for a hoop that can embroider at least 8” x 8”.



Designs with the letter **“B”** at the end are the medium designs for a hoop that can embroider at least 7” x 7”.



Designs with the letter **“C”** at the end are the small designs for a hoop that can embroider at least 6” x 6”.

Each of the block designs come in five sizes. Each of the 5 sizes look wonderful. Of course, the larger sizes take longer to embroider. We created all of our samples using the “A” size.



Designs with the letter **“D”** at the end are the smallest designs for a hoop that can embroider at least 5” x 5”.



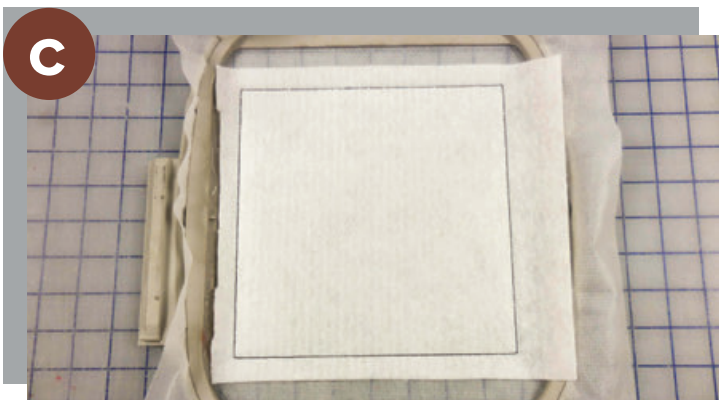
## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS



To start, hoop 2 pieces of No-show Mesh stabilizer and stitch step 1 of the design. This is the squaring stitch.



Place a piece of batting over the squaring stitches.



Stitch step 2 of the design. This is the tack down stitch for the batting.



After the tack down stitch, trim away all of the excess batting.



Step 3 of the design is the placement stitch for the first piece of appliqué, which will be the sky.



Lay the appliqué covering the placement stitches. Be sure to leave at least 1/2" seam allowance on all sides.

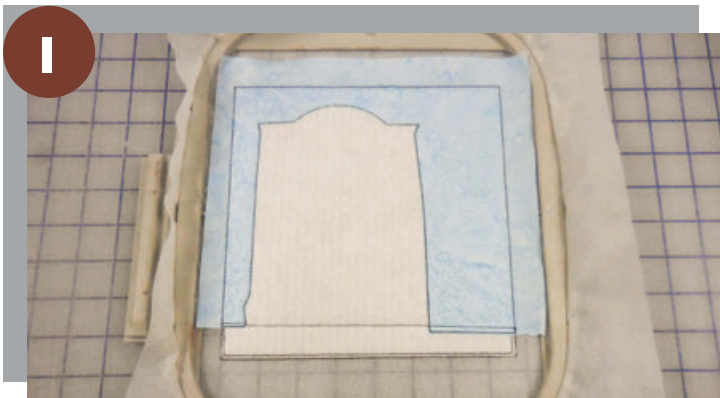
## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS



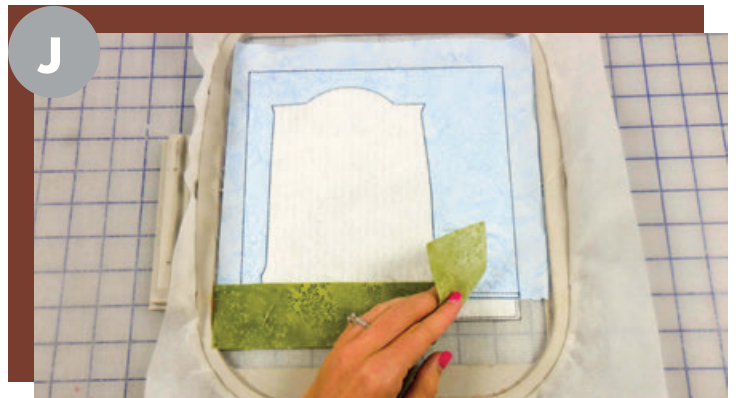
Next will be the tack down stitch for the appliqué.



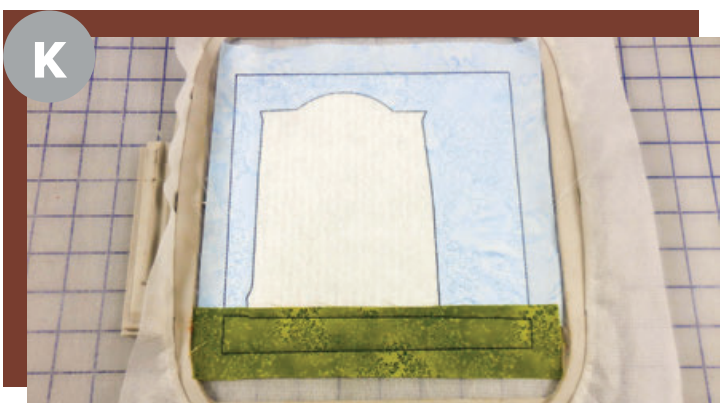
Trim away all excess fabric from the tack down stitches. **Be sure to leave the excess on the outside of the block.** You will need this later for the seam allowance.



Stitch the placement stitch for the second piece of appliqué. This is for the ground.



Place your ground appliqué. Again, be sure to leave an excess of  $\frac{1}{2}$ " on the outside edges of the block.

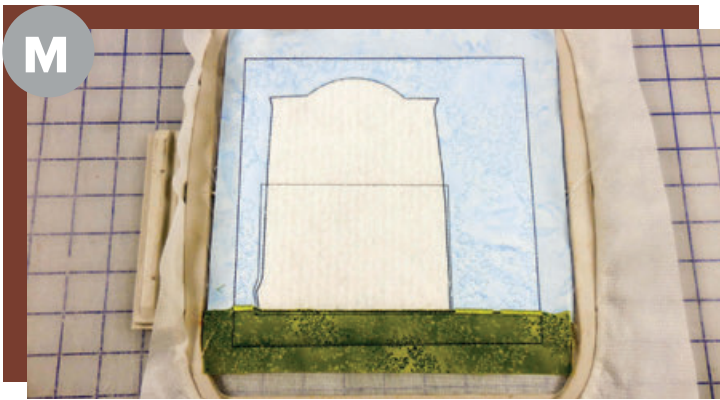


Continue with the tack down stitch.



Trim away all excess fabric from the inside of the block only. You will need the excess on the outside for the seam allowance. This is how the landscape effect is created. A satin stitch will cover the raw edges of the appliqué piece.

## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS



**M** Each remaining piece of appliqué will begin with a placement stitch.



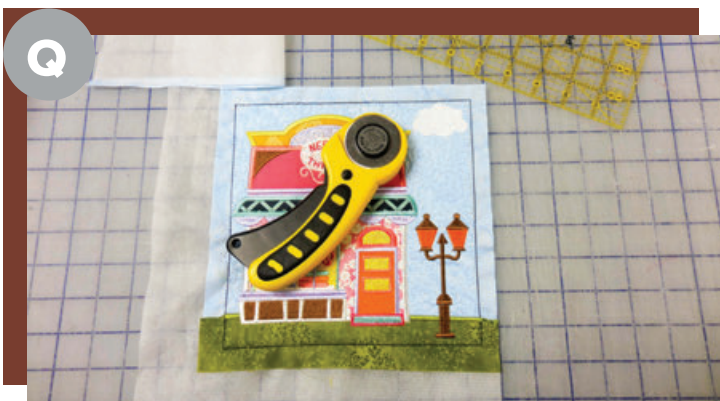
**N** You will then place the appliqué fabric.



**O** And continue with the tack down stitch.



**P** Then trim the excess appliqué fabric.



**Q** Remove your finished design from the hoop and using a ruler and rotary cutter, trim the design to a ½" seam allowance on all sides.



**R** A finished block should look like this.
