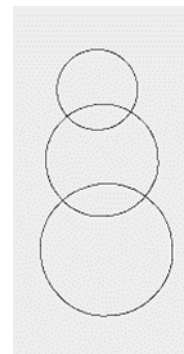
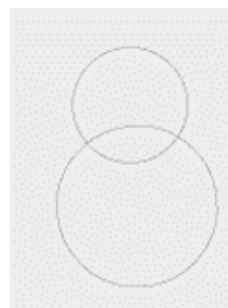

### Creating the Snowman:

1. Click on IQ Designer 
2. Click on the Shapes Icon 
3. Select the Circle Shape 
4. Click OK
5. Click on Size 
6. Reduce the Size to 2.25" (Face)
7. Click OK
8. Drag the Circle to the top of the screen
9. Click on the Duplicate Icon 
10. Click on Size 
11. Increase the Size to 3.15" (Middle Circle)
12. Move the circle below the first circle and so that it is overlapping the first circle
13. Click OK
14. Click on the Duplicate Icon
15. Click on Size
16. Change the Size to 3.70" (Bottom Circle)
17. Click on Move and move this copied Circle below the Middle Circle – making sure it is overlapping the Middle Circle
18. Click OK



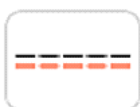
19. Click on the Eraser Icon

20. Change the number to 10 and the option to Square. Click OK

21. Delete the Overlapped Areas



22. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



23. Select the Double Run Icon

24. Click on Red

25. Click OK



26. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

27. Touch the Snowman

28. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

*(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow Machines Memory*



*then click on Machine*

29. Click Next

30. Click on Set and Click OK when the message pop up

*(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)*

31. Click Add

### Creating the Buttonhole:

1. Click on IQ Designer



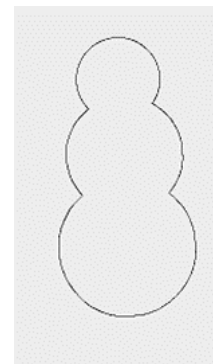
2. Click on the Shapes Icon

3. Click on the Square Shape



4. Click OK

5. Click on Size



6. Reduce the Size to H = .39" and W = 1.30"



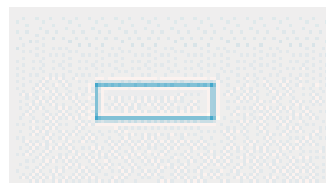
7. Click OK

8. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

9. Select the Satin Stitch Option



10. Change Color to Blue



11. Click OK

12. Click the Bucket/Cup Icon

13. Touch the Buttonhole

14. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

15. (for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow Machines Memory)



then click on Machine

16. Click Next

17. Click on Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

18. Click on Edit

19. Click on Size



20. Click on the Re-Size Icon

21. When the message pops up click OK

22. Reduce the Size to H = .30" and W = .82"



23. Click OK

24. Click Edit

25. Click on Move and using the arrows move the button hole towards the left part of the Middle Circle

26. Click on Edit

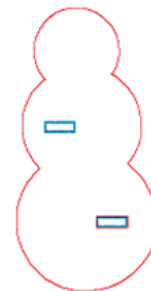


27. Click on the Duplicate Icon

28. Click Move and Move this Buttonhole to the right side of the bottom circle

29. Click OK

30. Click Add



### Creating the Eyes:

1. Click IQ Designer



2. Click on the Shapes Icon

3. Click on the Solid Shapes



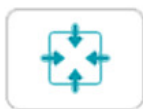
4. Click on the Circle Shape



5. Click OK

6. Click on Size

7. Reduce the Size to .39"



8. Click OK

9. Click Next

10. Click on Set and Click OK when the message pop up

*(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)*

11. Click on Edit

12. Click on Size (the eye needs to be resized further)

13. Click on the Re-Size Icon



14. When the message pops up click OK

15. Reduce the Size proportionally to .26"



16. Use the arrows to move the eye into the correct position

17. Click OK

18. Click on the Duplicate Icon



19. Click on Move

20. Move the second eye into the correct position

21. Click Add

### **Creating the Smile:**

1. Click on IQ Designer



2. Click on the Shapes Icon

3. Click on the Circle

4. Click OK

5. Click on Size

6. Reduce the size proportionally to .75"



7. Click OK

8. Click on the Eraser Icon

9. Reduce the size to 10 and change the option to square. Click OK

10. Zoom in to 400%

11. Erase the Top Half of the Circle



12. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



13. Select the Double Run Icon

14. Change Color to Purple

15. Click OK



16. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

17. Click on the Smile you just created

18. Click on Next

19. Click on Set and Click OK when the message pop up

*(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)*

20. Click on Edit

21. Click on Move

22. Using the arrows move the smile into the correct position

23. Click OK

24. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

25. *(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow  
Machines Memory*



*then click on Machine*

26. Click Embroidery to embroider your design
