Creating the Outside Shape of the Towel Topper: (Placement Line)

1. Open Up the Settings Page and Change the Hoop Size to 9 ½" x 9 ½"

2. Click on IQ Designer



3. Click on the Shapes Icon



4. Select the Rounded Square Shape  (Row 1 Column 2)

5. Click OK

6. Click on Size

7. Reduce the Size to H = 4.77"



and W = 4.77"



8. Click OK

9. Drag the Square to the bottom of the hoop

10. Click on the Shapes Icon

11. Click on the Oval Shape  (Row 3 Column 5)

12. Click OK

13. Click on Rotate

14. Click on 90 Degrees to the right

15. Click OK

16. Click on Size

17. Change the Size to H = 1.87" and W = 5.13"



18. Using the arrows move the Oval so it overlaps the square. Make sure it is still within the hoop boundary and is centered within the square

19. Click OK

20. Click on the Eraser Icon



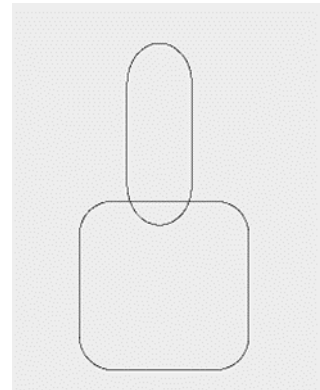
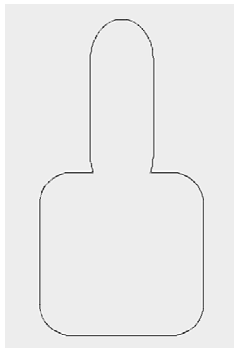
21. Change the Size to 10 and Select the Square Option

22. Click OK

23. Zoom to 400%

24. Delete the Overlapping Stitches

25. Click on the Shapes Icon



26. Select the Square Shape (Row 1 Column 1)

27. Click OK

28. Click on Size

29. Reduce the Size to H = .83"



and W = 3.27"



30. Use the arrows and move the rectangle box towards the bottom of the towel topper

31. Click OK

32. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow then click on Machine Machines Memory)



33. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

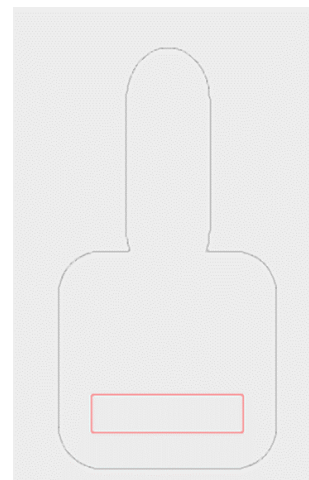


34. Select the Double Run Icon



35. Change the Color to Red

36. Click OK



37. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon



38. Touch the Outline and the Inner Rectangle

39. Click Next

40. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(for Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

Creating the Tackdown Line:

1. Click on Add

2. Click on IQ Designer

3. Select the Pocket with the Arrow



(for the Destiny click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)

4. Select the Machines Memory

5. Select the Design you just created

6. Click OK

7. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



8. Select the Double Run Icon

9. Change the Color to Green

10. Click OK

11. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

12. Touch the Outline and the Inner Rectangle

13. Click Next

14. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

Creating the Tackdown Line for the Back Piece:

1. Click on Add

2. Click on IQ Designer

3. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow

(for the Destiny click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)

4. Select the Machines Memory

5. Select the original design you created

6. Click OK

7. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

8. Select the Double Run Icon

9. Change the Color to Blue

10. Click OK

11. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

12. Touch the Outline and the Inner Rectangle

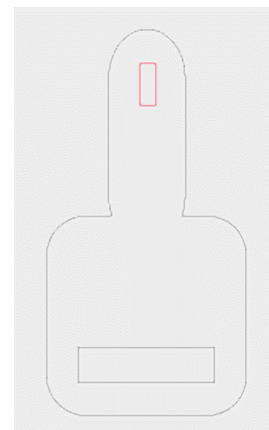
13. Click Next

14. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

15. Click on Add

1. Click on IQ Designer
2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow
(for the Destiny click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



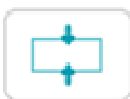
3. Select the Original Design you created
4. Click OK
5. Click on the Shapes Icon

6. Select the Square Shape  (Row 1 Column 1)

7. Click OK

8. Click on Size

9. Reduce the Size to H = .98"



and W = .39"



10. Use the Arrows and move the buttonhole to the top of the oval

11. Click OK

12. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

13. Select the Satin Stitch Icon



14. Change the Color to Purple

15. Click OK

16. Click on Bucket/Cup Icon

17. Touch the Outline, the Rectangle and then the Buttonhole

18. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

*(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow
Machines Memory)*



then click on Machine

19. Click on Next

20. Using the arrows to select the different parts of the design, Change the following settings:

- Outline W = .240" and Density 110%
- Buttonhole W =.20"
- Rectangle Box W = .240" and Density 110%



21. Click Set

22. Click OK at the message

23. Click Add

Adding the Lettering:

1. Click the Fonts Folder
2. Click on Font Style 7
3. Type in Home is
4. Click on Set
5. Click on Edit
6. Click on Rotate
7. Rotate the Words Home is so that it is at an angle
8. Click OK
9. Click on Size
10. Reduce the size so it fits nicely inside the Towel Topper
11. Move it to a pleasing position
12. Click OK
13. Click on Add
14. Click on Fonts



15. Click on Font Style 7
16. Type in Where the
17. Click on Set
18. Click on Edit
19. Click on Size
20. Resize the Words
21. Move it to a pleasing position
22. Click on OK
23. Click on Add
24. Click on Fonts
25. Click on Font Style 7
26. Type in Is
27. Click on Edit
28. Click on Size
29. Resize the word
30. Move it to a pleasing position
31. Click OK

Adding the Heart:

1. Click on Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Click on the Shapes Icon

4. Select the Filled Shapes Icon



5. Select the Heart



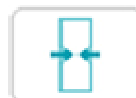
6. Click OK

7. Click on Size

8. Resize the Heart to H = 1.00"



W = 1.02"



9. Click OK

10. Click Next

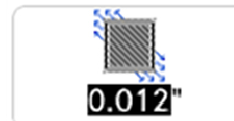
11. Click on the Angle Icon and
Click on Manual and change the angle to 45 Degrees



12. Click Set



13. Click on OK at the message



14. Click on Edit

15. Click on Move and move the heart to a position



16. Click on Rotate and rotate the heart and click OK

17. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

18. (for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow
Machines Memory)



then click on Machine

19. Click Embroidery

20. You are Done 😊

Supplies Needed:

1. Two Pieces of 6" X 10" Fabric for the Towel Topper
2. Two Pieces of No Show Water Soluble Mesh to Fit the 9 ½" x 9 ½" Hoop
3. One Piece of 6" Fiber Form
4. Print the Template from the CD
5. 505 Spray Adhesive
6. White 60Wt Bobbin Thread
7. One Bobbin wound with the same color as your satin stitch

Embroidering the Towel Topper:

1. Use the Template to cut a piece from the Fiber Form – Set it aside
2. Hoop 2 pieces of No Show Water Soluble Stabilizer in the 9 ½" x 9 ½" Hoop
3. Embroider Color 1 (Placement Line)
4. Spray the back the Fiber Form with 505 Spray and lay it on top of the stitching line
5. Next spray the wrong side of the top fabric and lay it over the entire placement line
6. Stitch out Color 2 (Tackdown Line)
7. Remove the hoop from the Machine. Trim close to the stitching line
8. ADVANCE TO COLOR NUMBER 5. Stitch out the Embroidery Details on the Front
Color 5 – Color 8
9. Remove the Hoop from the Machine
10. Spray the wrong side of the Back Fabric with 505 Spray and lay the piece on the back - Right Side Up
11. Stitch out Color 3 (Tackdown Line for the Back)

12. Remove Hoop from the Machine and Trim close to the stitching line on the Back AND INSIDE THE RECTANGLE
13. Change the bobbin with the same thread as the Top
14. Stitch out Color 4 (Final Satin Stitch)
15. Remove the Hoop from the machine
16. Cut Close to the stitching line
17. Soak the remaining stabilizer in water to remove
18. Once it is dry, use a buttonhole cutter to cut through the buttonhole
19. Fold tab to the back of the Hanger and mark the Buttonhole Placement Line
20. Use a thread on the top and in the bobbin that matches your front fabric and sew on a button
