ENHANCING YOUR IQ

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COFFEE MUG RUG

Supplies:

- Fat Quarter (18" x 22") of solid fabric
- ½ yard coffee print fabric
- Medium weight stabilizer
- Batting
- Assorted colors of embroidery threads
- All-purpose sewing thread
- Basic sewing supplies
- Point turner

Instructions:

- 1) Hoop the stabilizer and the solid fabric in the machine hoop.
- 2) Bring up the final Coffee Cup design you created and embroider the design using embroidery thread colors to coordinate with the coffee print fabric.
- 3) Once the embroidery is complete, remove the excess stabilizer.
- 4) Switch to sewing mode on the machine and thread with all-purpose thread.
- 5) Trim the piece down so that it is 6 1/2" wide by 7 1/4" tall.
- 6) From the coffee print fabric cut the side front piece 3 1/2" wide by 7 1/4" tall.
- 7) Sew the coffee print to the embroidered square. Press.
- 8) Layer the batting, backing, finished front piece and trim the batting and backing so they match your finished front piece in size.
- 9) Restack the fabrics in this order; batting finish front with right side facing up, then backing with right side facing down.
- 10) Stitch around the outer edge leaving a small opening for turning.
- 11) Turn the mug rug right side out. Use a point turner to completely turn the corners. Press.
- 12) Stitch the opening closed.
- 13) Grab a cup of coffee and Enjoy!

Creating the Coffee Cup Base Design:



1. Click on IQ Designer



2. Click on the Shapes Icon



3. Select the Closed Shapes Icon



4. Select the House



5. Click OK

6. Click on the Eraser Icon

7. Change the shape to Square and Click OK

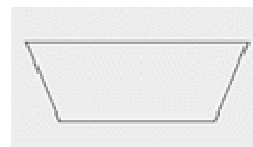
8. Erase everything but the roof of the house



9. Click on the Select Icon



10. Draw a box around the roof



11. Click on Rotate

12. Click on 90 Degrees to the right. Click on it twice

13. Click OK

14. Click on Size

15. Change the H = 1.20"



and the W=3.87



and use the arrows to move the base of the cup to the bottom of the screen



16. Click OK

17. Click on the Shapes Icon

18. Select the Shield  (Row 6 Column 5)

19. Click OK

20. Click the Eraser Icon

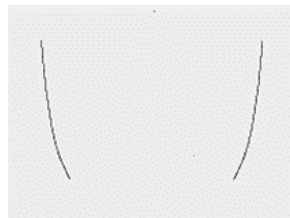
21. Change the size to 10 and select the square option. Click OK

22. Click OK

23. Click on the Settings Page and set the grid to 3/8".

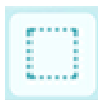
24. Click OK (using the grid will help you in the next step)

25. Erase the top and bottom half of the shield



26. Turn Off the grid

27. Click on the Select Icon



28. Draw a box around the Altered Shield

29. Click on Size

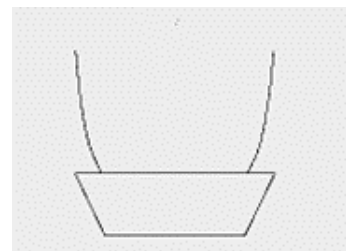
30. Change the size to H=2.84"



and W=3.84"



31. While it is still selected, use the arrows to move it so that it is touching the base of the cup. You may want to Zoom to 200%



32. Click OK

33. Click on the Shapes Icon

34. Click on the Square  (Row 1, Column 1)

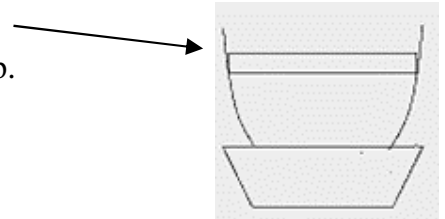
35. Click OK

36. Click on Size

37. Change the size to H=.39" and W=2.78"



38. Use the arrow to move the rectangle box to the inside of the cup.
You may have to resize your rectangle to make it fit inside the cup.
This will depend on where you place your rectangle.



39. Click OK

40. Click on the Shapes Icon

41. Select the Triangle  (Row 2 Column 4)

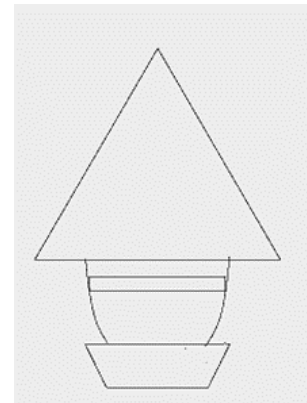
42. Click OK

43. Click on Size

44. Use the arrows to move the triangle on top of the cup

45. Click OK

46. Click on the Eraser Icon



47. Reduce the number to 10 and change it to a Square. Click OK
(for Destiny – select the smallest square)

48. Click OK

49. Erase all the extra lines - you should be left with a straight line

50. Click on the Shapes Icon

51. Select the Half Moon Shape  (Row 3 Column 4)

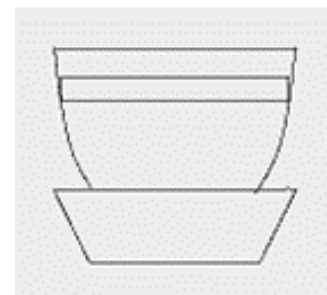
52. Click OK

53. Click on Rotate

54. Rotate 90 Degrees to the Right

55. Click OK

56. Click Size



57. Change size to H=.57"  and W=.96" 

58. Use the arrows to move it to the right side of the cup

59. Click OK



60. Click on Rotate

61. Rotate by one degree increments depending on the look you like

62. Click OK

63. Click on Duplicate 

64. Click on Size

65. Change size to Change size to H=.60"  and W=.30" 

66. Use the arrows to move it inside the first D shape (You may want to zoom in)

67. Click OK

68. Click on the Shapes Icon

69. Click on the Open Shapes Icon     

70. Select the Scroll Design  (Row 2 Column 4)

71. Click OK

72. Click on Rotate

73. Rotate 90 Degrees to the right

74. Click OK

75. Click on Size

76. Reduce size to H=1.80"  and W=.68" 

77. Use the arrows to place the scroll above the cup



78. Click OK

79. Click Duplicate

80. Click Size – use the arrows to position the 2nd scroll next to the first one

81. Click OK

Filling in the Design:

1. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



2. Select Fancy



3. Click Select

4. Choose Style 004

5. Click OK

6. Select Red

7. Click OK



8. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

9. Click inside the cup to fill with stitches (on the top and bottom of the rectangle)



10. Click on the Fill Regions Properties Icon

11. Select the Weave Stitch



12. Change the Color to Pink

13. Click OK

14. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

15. Click inside the Rectangle



16. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

17. Select Fancy



18. Click on Select

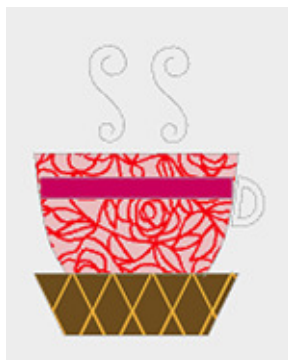
19. Choose Style 006

20. Click OK

21. Change the Color to Orange

22. Click OK

23. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon



24. Click inside the Base of the Cup

25. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

26. Select the Weave Stitch



27. Change the Color to Green

28. Click OK

29. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon



30. Click inside the handle

31. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

32. Select the Candlewicking Stitch



33. Change the Color to Purple

34. Click OK

35. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

36. Click on Both Scrolls

37. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

38. Select the Double Stitch Icon



39. Change the Color to Yellow

40. Click OK

41. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

42. Click on the outline of the cup and outlines of the handle



43. Click on Next



44. Use the arrows    until one part of the cup is selected

45. Click on the Link Icon    until both parts of the cup is selected

46. Click on Size

47. Change the size to 75% and Click OK (For Destiny click Set)

48. Change the Outline to OFF and Click OK (For Destiny click Set)

49. Use the arrows until the base of the cupcake is selected



50. Change the size to 50% and Click OK (*For Destiny click Set*)

51. Change the Outline to OFF and Click OK (*For Destiny click Set*)

52. Click on Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

53. Click Embroidery

54. Click on the Memory Icon

55. Click on the Machines Memory

56. You're design in now complete!
