# ENHANCING YOUR IQ

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## HOLIDAY WALL HANGING

### Supplies:

- ½ Yard solid fabric
- 1 Yard holiday print fabric
- Assorted holiday prints for the border
- Medium weight stabilizer
- Batting
- Assorted colors of embroidery threads
- All-purpose sewing thread
- Basic sewing supplies

### Instructions:

- 1) Hoop the stabilizer and the solid fabric in the machine hoop.
- 2) Bring up the ornament design you created and embroider the design using embroidery thread colors to coordinate with the holiday design printed fabric.
- 3) Once the embroidery is complete, remove the excess stabilizer.
- 4) Switch to sewing mode on the machine and thread with all-purpose thread.
- 5) Trim the piece down so that it is 16" wide by 10" tall.
- 6) For the border pieces, cut 2 ½ inch squares from an assortment of prints.
- 7) Piece ten strips together for each horizontal border and eight for each vertical border strip.
- 8) Sew the vertical border strips to the center embroidered square. Press. Trim off the excess length. Then sew the horizontal strips to each end of the front. Trim off the excess length to square up the front piece.
- 9) Using the remaining print fabric to cut a piece 20 ½" wide by 15 ¼" tall for the batting and backing.
- 10) Lay the finished front piece with right side facing up, then align the batting and backing piece to match. Pin in place.
- 11) Stitch around the outer edge with a ½" seam allowance leaving an opening for turning.
- 12) Turn the wall hanging right side out. Press.
- 13) Whipstitch the opening closed.

### Preparing the Ornaments:

1. Click on IQ Designer



2. Click on the Shapes Icon



3. Select the Circle  (Row 3 Column 1)

4. Click on OK

5. Click on Size

6. Reduce the Size Proportionately to the H = 3.85" and W = 3.85"



7. Use the arrows to move the circle to the left side of the screen

8. Click on OK

9. Click on the Duplicate Icon



10. Click on Size

11. Use the arrows to move the circle to the middle bottom of the screen

12. Click OK


13. Click on the Duplicate Icon

14. Click on Size

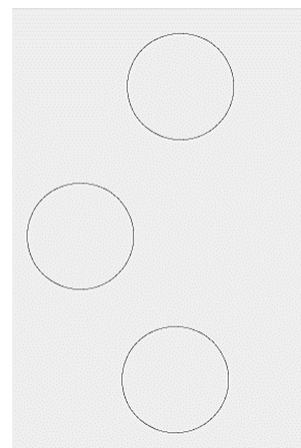
15. Use the arrows to move the circle to the middle bottom of the screen

16. Click OK

17. Click on the Shapes Icon

18. Select the Rounded Square  (Row 1 Column 2)

19. Click OK



20. Click on Size

21. Reduce the Size to H = 1.05"



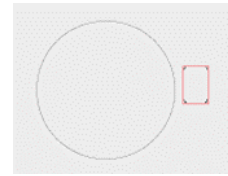
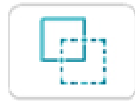

22. Use the arrows to move the square piece to the top ornament – leave space between the circle and the square

23. Click OK

24. Click on the Duplicate Icon



25. Click on Size

26. Use the arrows to move the square piece to the top ornament – leave space between the circle and the square

27. Click OK

28. Click on Duplicate

29. Click on Size

30. Use the arrows to move the square piece to the bottom ornament – leave space between the circle and the square

31. Click OK

32. Click on the Shapes Icon

33. Click on the Banner Shape (Row 4 Column 2)

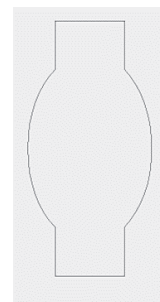


34. Click OK

35. Click on Rotate

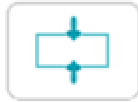
36. Rotate it 90 Degrees to the Right

37. Click OK

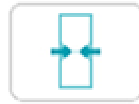


38. Click on Size

39. Decrease the size to H=2.70"



W =5.57"



40. While it is still selected, move the shape off to the right side of the screen

41. Click OK

42. Click on the Eraser Icon

43. Keep the number at 20 and select the square option. Click OK

44. Erase everything but the bottom curve shape

45. Click on Select



46. Draw a box around the Curve Shape – making sure to select just the curve shape and nothing else

47. Drag the curve shape and place it in the top half of the center ornament

48. Click on Size

49. Increase the height of the curve so that it extends beyond the circle

50. Click on Duplicate

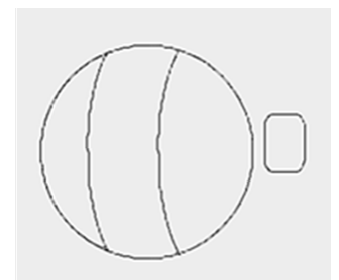
51. Drag the curve shape and place it in the bottom half of the center ornament

52. Click on the Eraser Icon

53. Change the number at 10 and select the square option. Click OK

54. Erase the excess lines that are outside of the circle. You may want to zoom in so that you can see

55. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

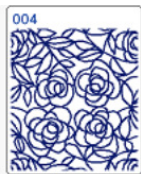


56. Select Fancy Fills



57. Click on Select

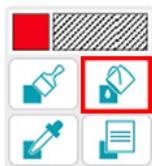
58. Click on 004



59. Click OK

60. Change Color to Pink

61. Click OK



62. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

63. Click inside of the Top Ornament

64. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

65. Change Color to Red

66. Click OK

67. Click on the Top and Bottom Sections of the Middle Ornament

68. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

69. Select Fancy Fills



70. Click on Select

71. Click on 001

72. Click OK

73. Change Color to Hot Pink

74. Click OK

75. Click Inside the Bottom Ornament

76. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

77. Select the Weave Fill Option



78. Change Color to Green

79. Click OK

80. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

81. Click inside all three of the rectangle boxes

82. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

83. Select the Weave Fill Option

84. Change Color to Purple

85. Click OK

86. Click inside the Center Ornament

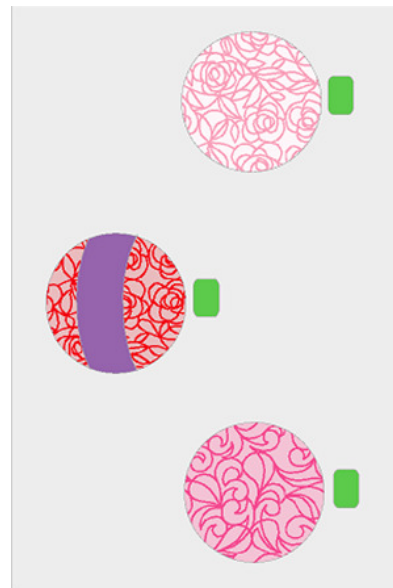
87. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

88. Select the Chainstitch Option



89. Change Color to Blue

90. Click OK



91. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

92. Click on the Outline of the Top Ornament

93. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

100. Select the Candlewicking Option



101. Change Color to Rust

102. Click OK

103. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

104. Click on the Outline of the Middle and Bottom Ornament

105. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

106. Select the Double Run Icon



107. Click on Yellow

108. Click OK

109. Click on the outline of the three rectangle boxes

110. Click on the Shapes Icon



111. Select the Open Shapes Option

112. Select the Bow



(Row 4 Column 1)

113. Click OK

114. Click on Rotate

115. Rotate in 90 Degrees to the Right

116. Use the arrows to move it to the right of the screen

117. Click OK

118. Click on Size

119. Decrease the size to H = .70"  and W=4.17"  Click OK

120. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

121. Click on the Candlewicking Icon

122. Change Color to Dark Blue

123. Click OK

124. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

125. Touch the Bow

126. Click on the Select Icon and draw a box around the Bow

127. Click on Size

128. Use the arrows to move the Bow on top of Square of the center ornament

129. Click OK

130. Click on the Duplicate Icon

131. Drag the 2<sup>nd</sup> bow and place it on top of another ornament

132. Click on the Duplicate Icon again

133. Draw the third bow and place it on top of the last ornament

134. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

*(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow  
Memory)*



*then click on Machine Machines*

135. Save the design to the Machines Memory.

136. Click Next

137. The Top Ornament is selected – Reduce the size to 75%

138. Click Off for the Outline

139. Use the arrow keys until the bottom ornament is selected



140. Change the size to 60%



141. Turn the Outline OFF

142. Use the arrows until the bow is selected

143. Click on the Link Icon



144. Change the size of the Candlewicking Stitch to .120"

145. Use the Arrows until the Chainstitch is Selected

146. Change the size to .140"

147. Click Set

148. When the message pops up click on OK

149. Click on the Memory Icon

150. Save it to the Machines Memory

151. Click on Embroidery
