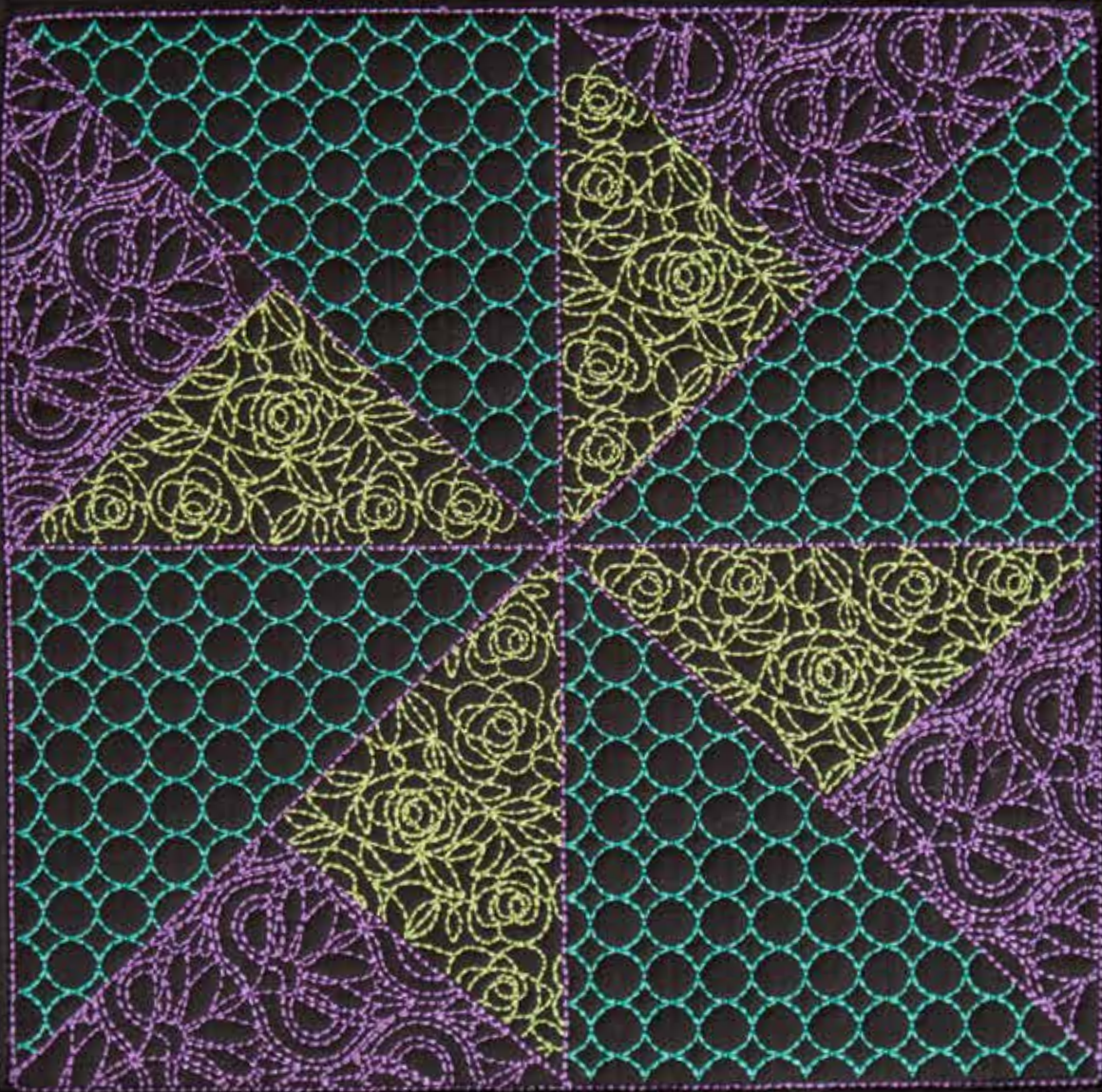



BLOCK 1 & 8

Creating Placement Line for Batting:




1. Click on IQ Designer 
2. Select the Shapes Icon 
3. Select the Square 
4. Click on Size
5. Change the Size to H = 8.00" and W = 8.00"
6. Click OK
7. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
8. Click on the Double Run Icon 
9. Click OK
10. Change the Color to Red
11. Click OK 
12. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
13. Click on the Memory and Save the design to the Machine's Memory
14. Click Next
15. Click Set and OK






Creating Tackdown Line for the Batting:

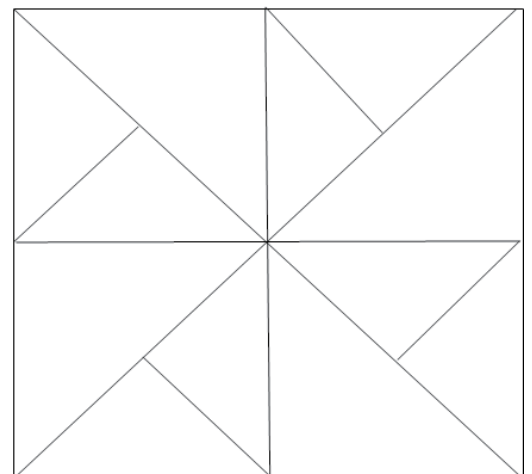
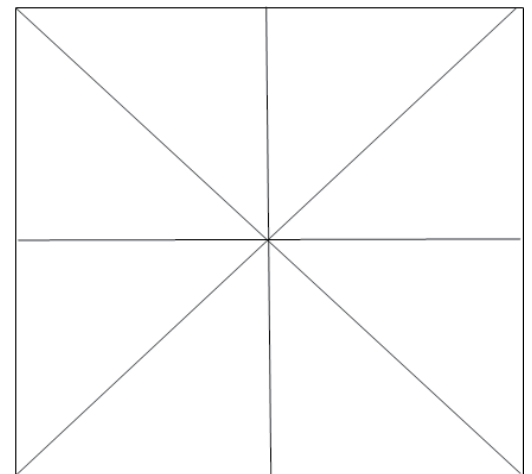
1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Click on the Double Run Icon 
6. Click OK
7. Change the Color to Green
8. Click OK 
9. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
10. Click Next
11. Click Set and OK

Creating the Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Click on the Double Run Icon 
6. Click OK
7. Change the Color to Blue
8. Click OK
9. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
10. Click Next
11. Click Set and OK

Creating the Block:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Select the Straight Line Icon 
6. Select the Triple Stitch Icon 
7. Click OK
8. Change the Color to Red
9. Click OK
10. Draw a Vertical Line down the Center of the Box
11. Next draw a Horizontal Line down the Center of the Box
12. Draw Two Diagonal Lines from Corner to Corner
13. Lastly, Draw the Sub Lines
14. Now it is time to clean up
15. Click on the Eraser Icon
16. Change the shape to a Square and increase the Size to 35
17. Zoom to 400%
18. Delete all the excess lines



19. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



20. Click on the Triple Stitch

21. Change the Color to Brown

22. Click OK

23. Click on Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property



and Touch all the lines

24. Save the design to the Machine's Memory

Filling In the Block:

1. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



2. Click on Fancy Fills



3. Click on the word Select

4. Select Fancy Fill #005

5. Click OK

6. Change the Color to Orange

7. Click OK

8. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon



Click Inside the Big Triangle

9. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



10. Click on the word Select

11. Select Fancy Fill #004



12. Click OK

13. Change the Color to Green

14. Click OK

15. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon



and Click Inside the four of the Small

Triangles

16. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



17. Click on the word Select



18. Select Fancy Fill #020

19. Click OK

20. Change the Color to Beige

21. Click OK



22. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon



and Click Inside the remaining four

of the Small Triangles

23. Click Next

24. Use the Arrow and navigate to the Orange
25. Click on the Link Icon 
26. Change the Size to 50%
27. Use the Arrow to navigate to the Green
28. Click on the Link Icon 
29. Change the Size to 50%
30. Use the Arrow to navigate to the Beige
31. Change the Size to 50%
32. Click on Set and OK
33. Click on Embroidery
34. Click on the Memory Icon and Save the design to the Machine's Memory

Embroidering Blocks 1 and 8: (Same block embroidered in different colors)

1. Hoop a piece of No Show Cutaway Stabilizer in the 9 ½" x 9 ½" Hoop
2. Stitch Out Color 1: Placement Line on top of the stabilizer
3. Lay your Batting on top of the Placement Line.
4. Stitch Out Color 2: Tackdown Stitch for the Batting
5. Remove the Hoop from the machine and trim the batting close to the stitching line
6. Lay the Background Fabric on top of the Batting
7. Stitch Out Color 3: Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric
8. Stitch Out Color 4: Fill #1
9. Stitch Out Color 5: Fill #2
10. Stitch Out Color 6: Fill #3
11. Stitch Out Color 7: Entire Block
12. When you are done remove the fabric from the hoop.
13. Cut all around the block, leaving ½ Seam Allowance on all 4 sides of the block
