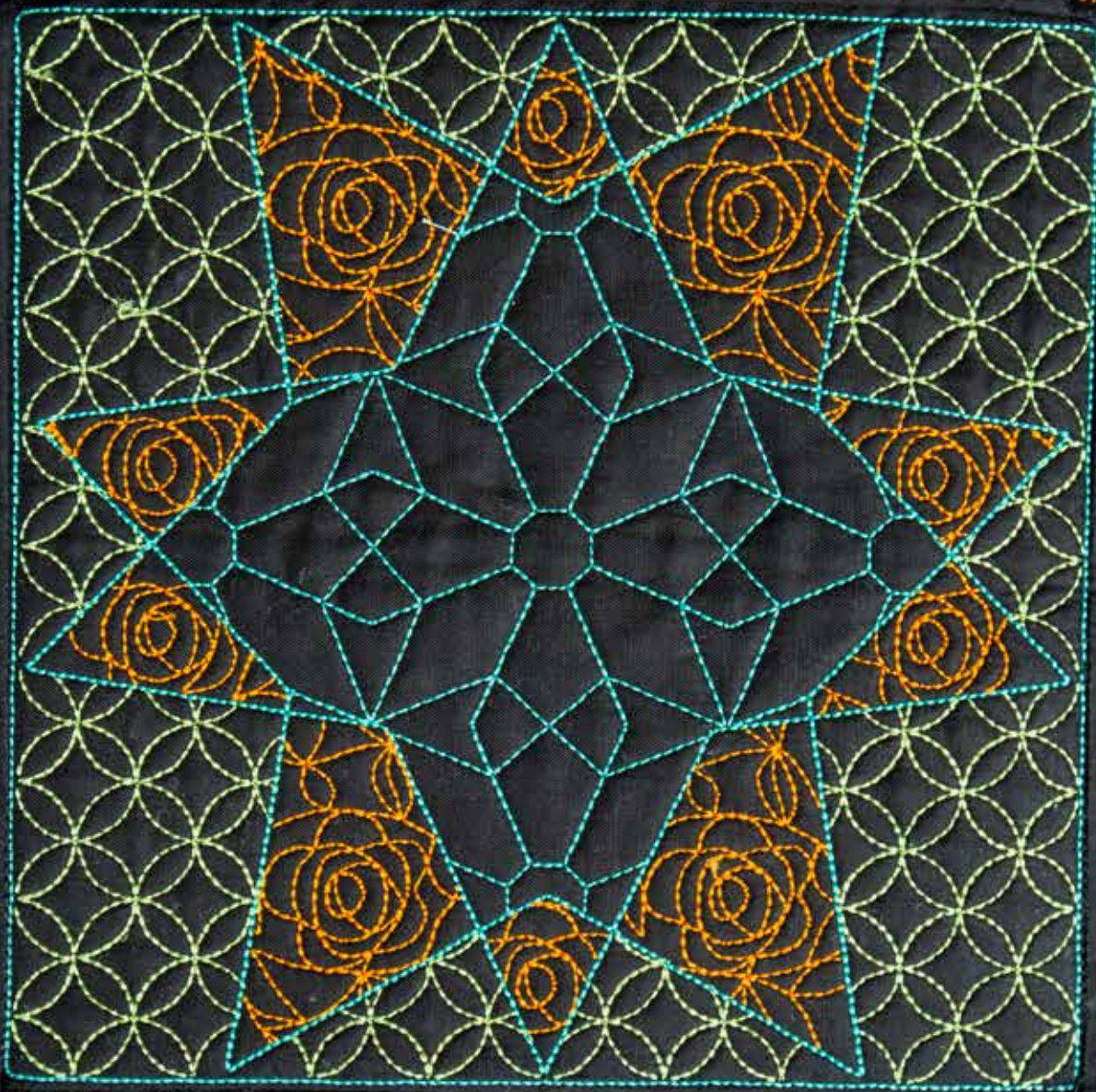

BLOCK 5

Creating Placement Line for Batting:

1. Go to the Settings Page and change the Grid to 1" and turn on the cross hairs

2. Click on IQ Designer



3. Select the Shapes Icon



4. Select the Square

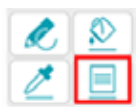


5. Click on Size

6. Change the Size to H = 8.00" and W = 8.00"

7. Click OK

8. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



9. Click on the Double Run Icon

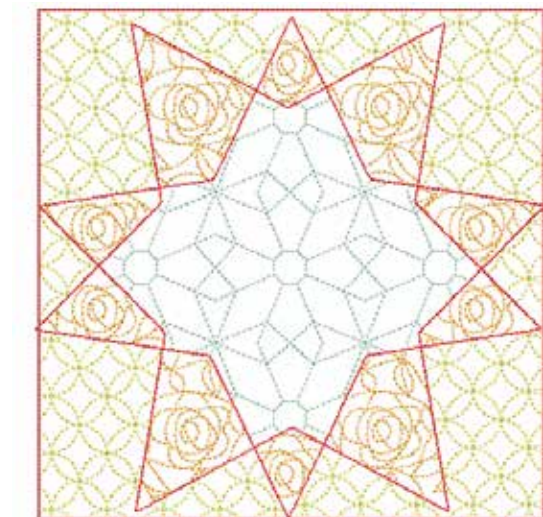


10. Click OK

11. Change the Color to Red

12. Click OK

13. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property



and Touch the Square

14. Click on the Memory and Save the design to the Machine's Memory

15. Click Next

16. Click Set and OK

Creating Tackdown Line for the Batting:

1. Click Add

2. Click on IQ Designer

3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory

4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



5. Click on the Double Run Icon



6. Click OK

7. Change the Color to Green

8. Click OK

9. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property






and Touch the Square




10. Click Next

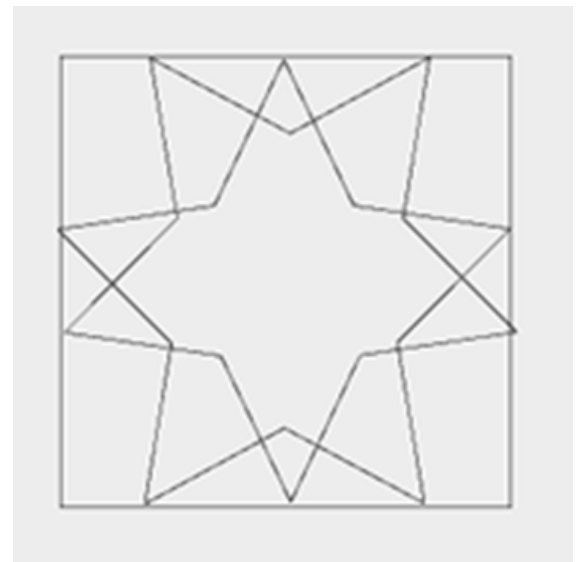
11. Click Set and OK


Creating the Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Click on the Double Run Icon 
6. Click OK
7. Change the Color to Blue
8. Click OK
9. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
10. Click Next
11. Click Set and OK


Creating the Block:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Shapes Icon
5. Select the Star (Row 5 Column 3)
6. Click OK
7. Click on the Size Icon
8. Change the Size to H = 7.82" and W = 8.04"
9. Click OK
10. Click on the Duplicate Icon
11. Click on Rotate and Rotate the Second star to 180 Degrees
12. Click OK
13. Move the Second Star so that it is in the center of the Square
14. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
15. Select the Straight Line Icon 
16. Select the Triple Stitch Icon 
17. Click OK
18. Change the Color to Red

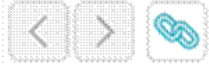


19. Click OK
20. Click on Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch all the lines
21. Save the design to the Machine's Memory

Filling In Block 5:

1. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon 
2. Click on Fancy Fills
3. Click on the word Select
4. Select Fancy Fill #029  
5. Click OK
6. Change the Color to Turquoise
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon  Click Inside the Center of the Star
9. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon 
10. Click on the word Select
11. Select Fancy Fill #004  
12. Click OK
13. Change the Color to Orange
14. Click OK
15. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon  and Click Inside the Star Points
16. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon 
17. Click on the word Select
18. Select Fancy Fill #025  
19. Click OK
20. Change the Color to Yellow
21. Click OK
22. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon  and Click Inside the remaining areas
23. Click Next
24. Use the Arrow and navigate to the Turquoise
25. Click on the Link Icon 
26. Change the Size to 120%
27. Use the Arrow and navigate to the Yellow

28. Click on the Link Icon



29. Change the Size to 75%

30. Leave the Orange at the default size

31. Click on Set and OK

32. Click on Embroidery

33. Click on the Memory Icon and Save the design to the Machine's Memory

Embroidering Block 5:

1. Hoop a piece of No Show Cutaway Stabilizer in the 9 ½" x 9 ½ Hoop
2. Stitch Out Color 1: Placement Line on top of the stabilizer
3. Lay your Batting on top of the Placement Line.
4. Stitch Out Color 2: Tackdown Stitch for the Batting
5. Remove the Hoop from the machine and trim the batting close to the stitching line
6. Lay the Background Fabric on top of the Batting
7. Stitch Out Color 3: Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric
8. Stitch Out Color 4: Fill #1
9. Stitch Out Color 5: Fill #2
10. Stitch Out Color 6: Fill #3
11. Stitch Out Color 7: Entire Block
12. When you are done remove the fabric from the hoop.
13. Cut all around the block, leaving ½ Seam Allowance on all 4 sides of the block
