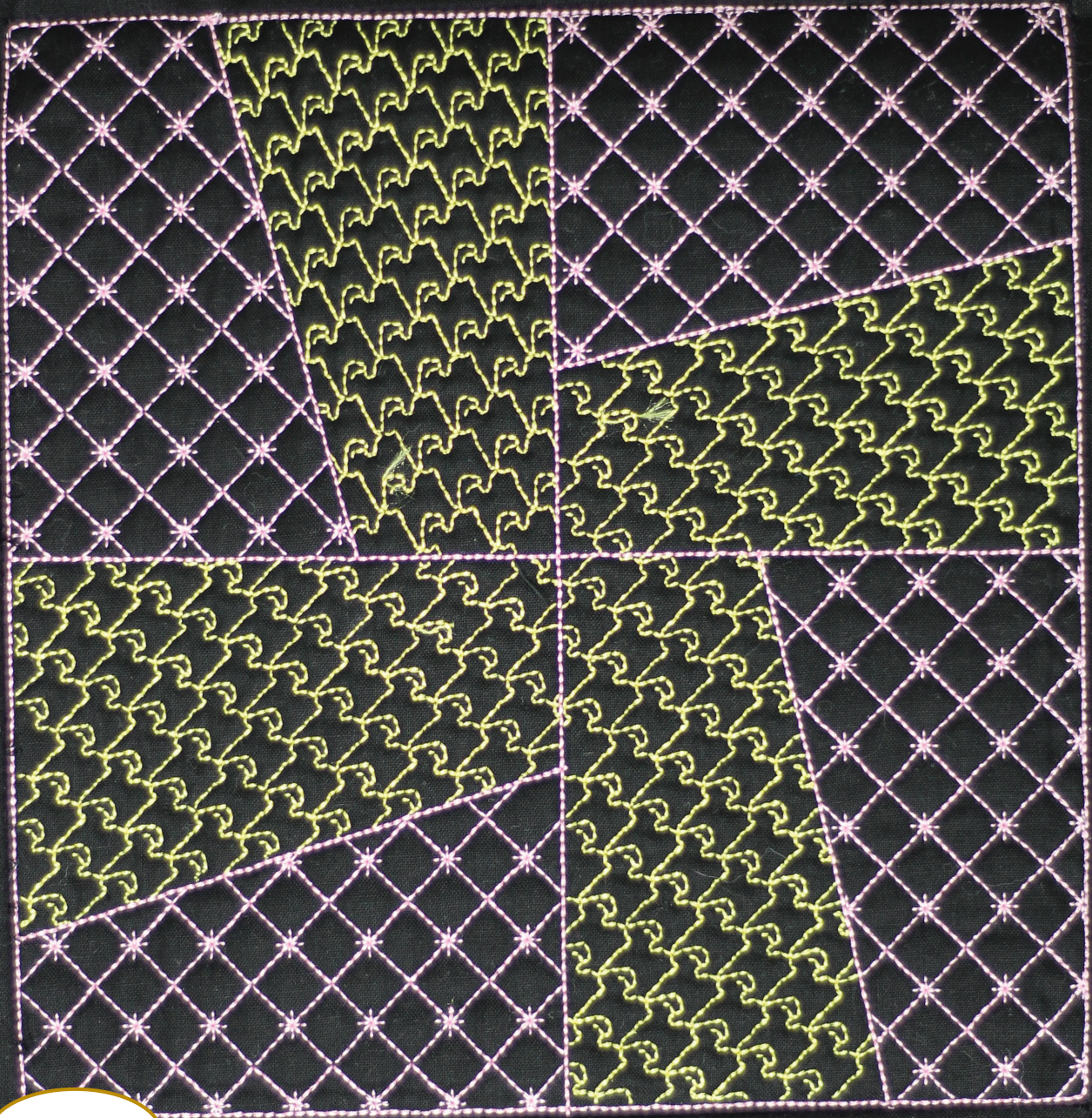

### BLOCK 6

#### Creating Placement Line for Batting:

1. Go to the Settings Page and change the Grid to 1" and turn on the cross hairs

2. Click on IQ Designer 

3. Select the Shapes Icon 


4. Select the Square 

5. Click on Size

6. Change the Size to H = 8.00" and W = 8.00"

7. Click OK

8. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 

9. Click on the Double Run Icon 

10. Click OK

11. Change the Color to Red

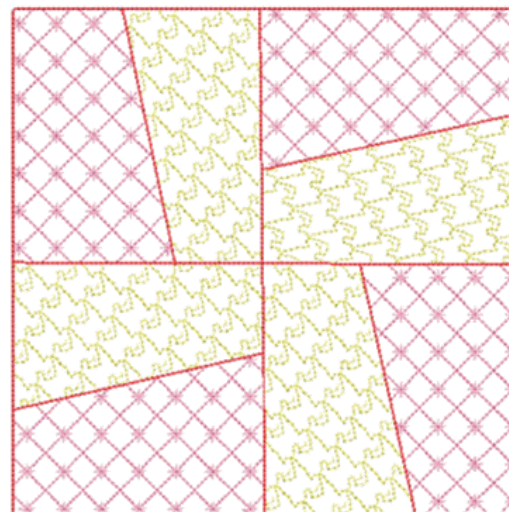
12. Click OK

13. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square

14. Click on the Memory and Save the design to the Machine's Memory

15. Click Next

16. Click Set and OK




#### Creating Tackdown Line for the Batting:

1. Click Add

2. Click on IQ Designer

3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory

4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 

5. Click on the Double Run Icon 

6. Click OK

7. Change the Color to Green





8. Click OK

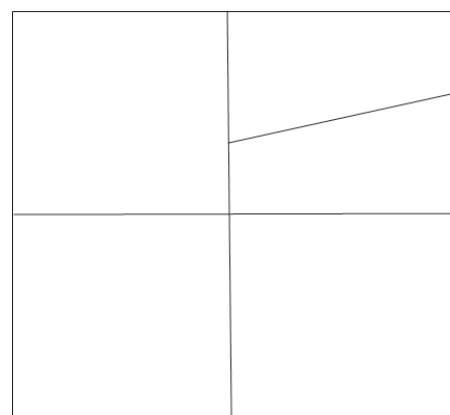
9. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square

10. Click Next




11. Click Set and OK

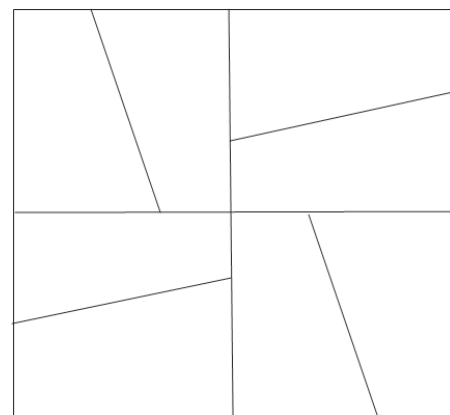
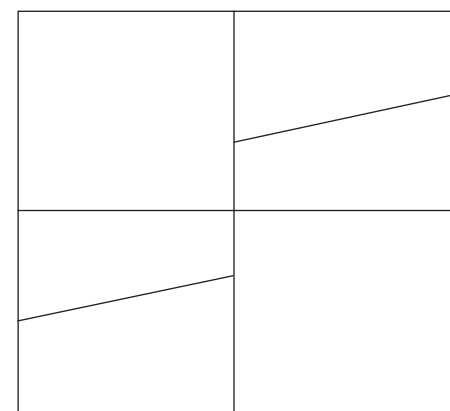
### Creating the Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric:



1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Click on the Double Run Icon  
6. Click OK
7. Change the Color to Blue
8. Click OK
9. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
10. Click Next
11. Click Set and OK












### Creating the Block:

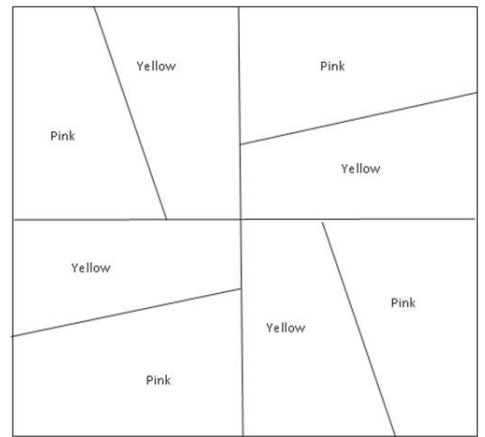
1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Select the Straight Line Icon 
6. Select the Triple Stitch Icon 
7. Click OK
8. Change the Color to Red
9. Click OK
10. Start with Drawing a Horizontal and Vertical Line down the center of the Square
11. Next draw One Line from 1 1/2" on the Center Vertical Line to the Outer Edge of the Square
12. Draw One Line from 1 1/2" on the Center Vertical Line to the Outer Edge of the Square
13. Repeat for the other two sides but from the Horizontal Line



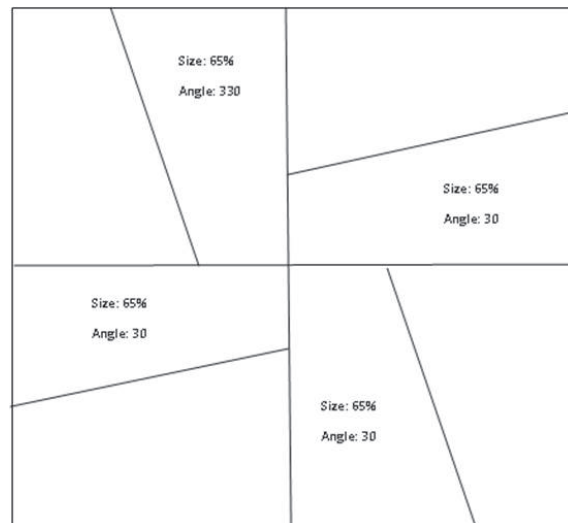
14. Now it is time to clean up. But before you do that, you can turn off the grid line and the cross hairs from the settings page. It will make it easier to see the lines
15. Click on the Eraser Icon
16. Change the shape to a Square and increase the Size to 35
17. Zoom to 400%
18. Delete all the excess lines
19. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
20. Click on the Triple Stitch
21. Change the Color to Red
22. Click OK
23. Click on Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch all the lines
24. Save the design to the Machine's Memory

### Filling In Block 6:

1. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon 
2. Click on Fancy Fills
3. Click on the word Select
4. Select Fancy Fill #009  
5. Click OK
6. Change the Color to Yellow
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon  Click Inside the areas (see diagram)
9. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon 
10. Click on the word Select
11. Select Fancy Fill #016  
12. Click OK
13. Change the Color to Pink
14. Click OK
15. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon  and Click Inside the Areas
16. Click Next
17. Use the Arrow and navigate to the Pink
18. Click on the Link Icon 



19. Change the Size to 75%
20. Use the Arrow and navigate to the Yellow (see diagram for sizes and angles)
21. Click on Set and OK
22. Click on Embroidery
23. Click on the Memory Icon and Save the design to the Machine's Memory



### Embroidering Block 6:

1. Hoop a piece of No Show Cutaway Stabilizer in the 9 ½" x 9 ½ Hoop
2. Stitch Out Color 1: Placement Line on top of the stabilizer
3. Lay your Batting on top of the Placement Line.
4. Stitch Out Color 2: Tackdown Stitch for the Batting
5. Remove the Hoop from the machine and trim the batting close to the stitching line
6. Lay the Background Fabric on top of the Batting
7. Stitch Out Color 3: Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric
8. Stitch Out Color 4: Fill #1
9. Stitch Out Color 5: Fill #2
10. Stitch Out Color 6: Entire Block
11. When you are done remove the fabric from the hoop.
12. Cut all around the block, leaving ½ Seam Allowance on all 4 sides of the block
