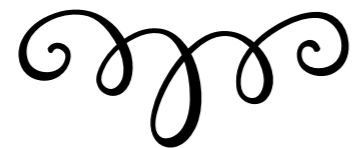

Let's Get Started!

Gather your supplies...

- Fabric 1 (Tan): Fat Quarter
- Fabric 2 (Orange): Scrap or Fat Quarter
- Pellon Perma-Stick Seam Tape
- Cotton Batting
- Pickle Pie Designs Machine Embroidery Scissors
- Pickle Pie Designs Duckbill Applique Scissors
- Mesh Cutaway Stabilizer
- Cotton Thread: Orange, Brown, Tan, Green (for Boy's Glasses)
- Microtex Needle, size 80/12

- All sizes listed are width x length.

Stitch Sequence:	For:	Thread Color:
1	Placement line for batting	Orange
2	Tack down batting	Orange
3	Tack down Fabric A/Quilting Stitches	Orange
4	Leaf swirl	Green
5	Stem	Brown
6	Placement line for Fabric A	Orange
7	Tack down Fabric A	Orange
8	Zigzag on Fabric A	Orange
9	Satin stitches and grooves on Fabric A	Orange
10	Eyes and mouth	Brown
11	Placement lines for Fabric B	Orange
12	Tack down Fabrics B and C	Orange

1	Placement line for batting	Orange
2	Tack down batting	Orange
3	Tack down Fabric A/Quilting Stitches	Orange
4	Leaf swirl	Green
5	Stem	Brown
6	Placement line for Fabric A	Orange
7	Tack down Fabric A	Orange
8	Zigzag on Fabric A	Orange
9	Satin stitches and grooves on Fabric A	Orange
10	Eyes and mouth	Brown
11	Glasses	Green
12	Placement lines for Fabric B	Orange
13	Tack down Fabrics B and C	Orange

Prep your Materials...

For each coaster, cut the following...

Fabric 1 (Tan):

For:	Label:	Cut to:
Front	A	5.5" x 5.5"
Back Piece 1	C	5.5" x 3" - Fold to 5.5" x 2.5"
Back Piece 2	D	5.5" x 5"

Fabric 2 (Orange):

For:	Label:	Cut to:
Applique	B	4" x 3.5"

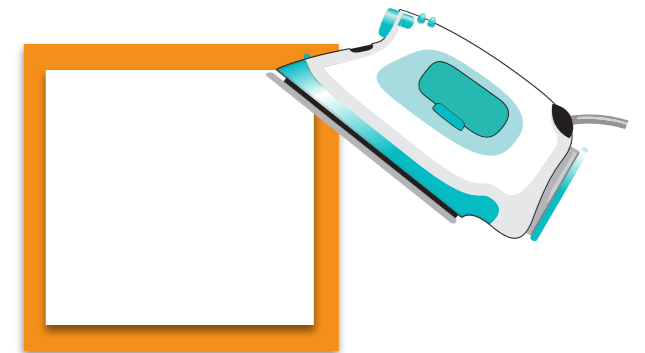
Fusible Webbing...

Cut to:
3.5" x 3"

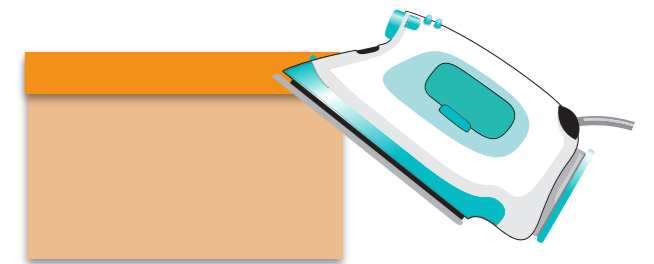
Batting...

Cut to:
5" x 5"

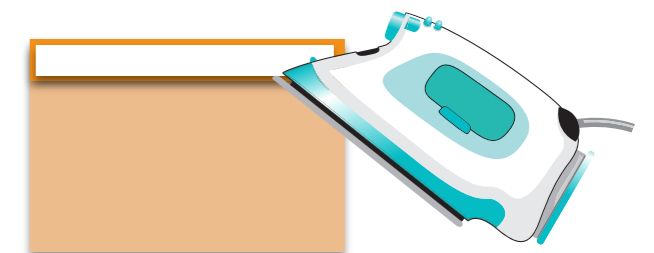
- Press fusible webbing to the back of Fabric B.



- Fold back Fabric C by 1/2", wrong sides together. Press to crease.



- Place a strip of fusible seam tape on the right side of the 1/2" strip. Press in place. Leave the paper backing on the seam tape. Set aside.



Fabric Labels

Keep track of your fabric cuts with these fabric labels. Just cut them out then pin or clip to your cut fabrics! (Makes 4 coasters.)

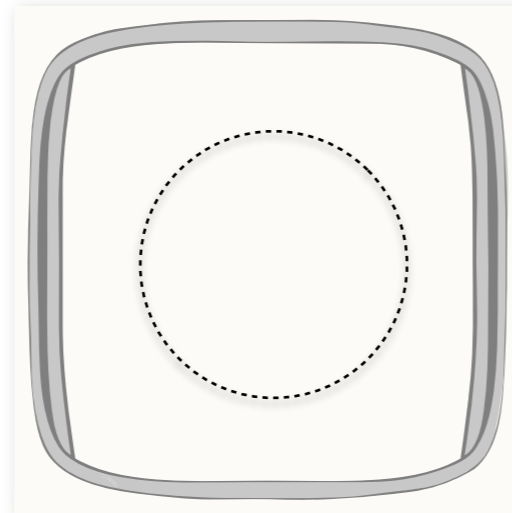
Let's Stitch Part 1...

Load the design to your embroidery machine.

Step 1:

Hoop a piece of stabilizer.

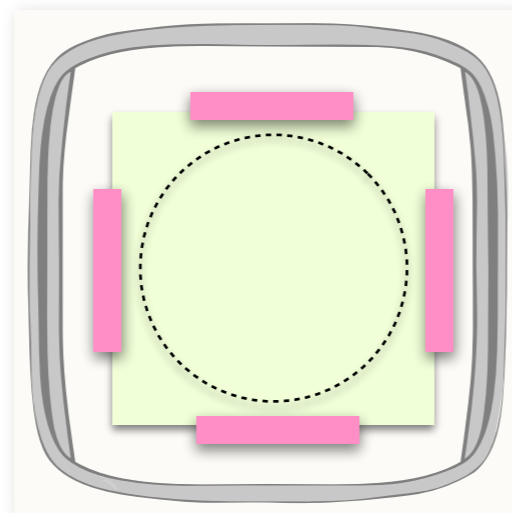
Using orange thread, sew **Stitch Sequence 1** to stitch a placement line for the batting.



Step 2:

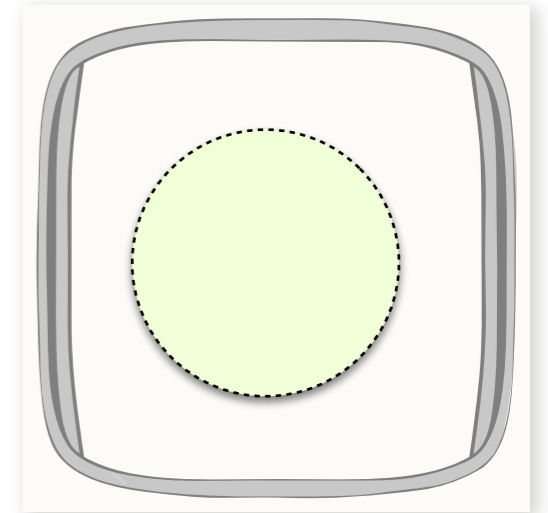
Center the batting over the placement line. Tape in place.

Sew **Stitch Sequence 2** to stitch a cutting line on the batting.



Step 3:

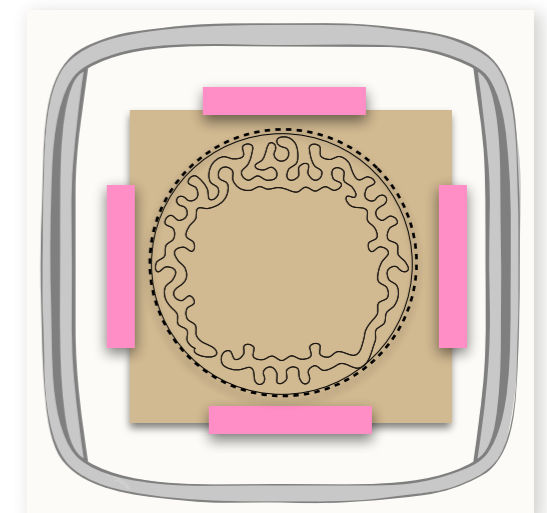
Remove the hoop from your machine. Using Pickle Pie Designs Duckbill Applique Scissors, trim the batting around the outside of the cutting line. This will lessen the bulk in the seam of the finished project.



Step 4:

Center Fabric A over the batting, right side up, and tape in place.

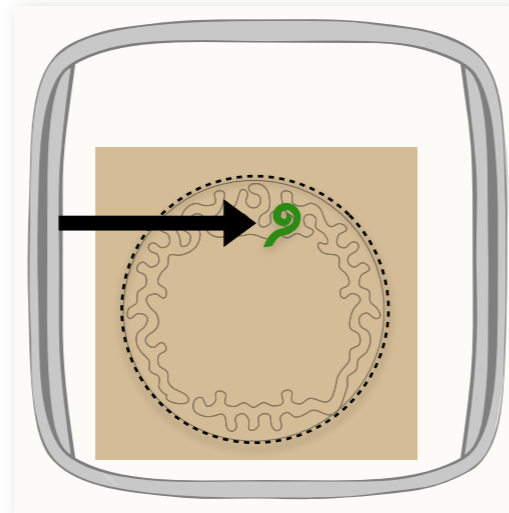
Put the hoop back on your machine and sew **Stitch Sequence 3** to tack down the fabric and sew the quilting stitches.



Step 5:

Change to green thread.

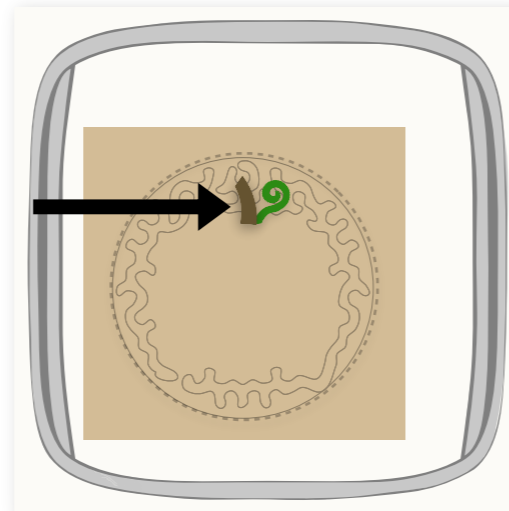
Sew **Stitch Sequence 4** to sew the leaf swirl.



Step 6:

Change to brown thread.

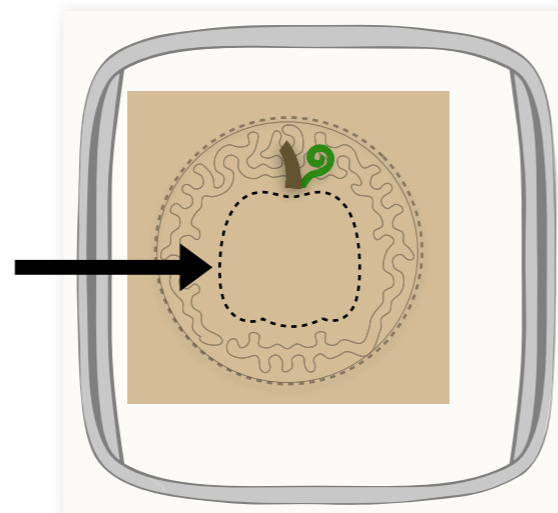
Sew **Stitch Sequence 5** to sew the stem.



Step 7:

Change to orange thread.

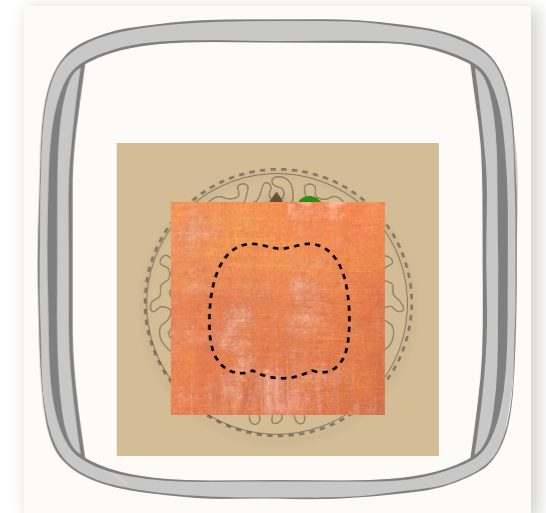
Sew **Stitch Sequence 6** to sew a placement line for Fabric B.



Step 8:

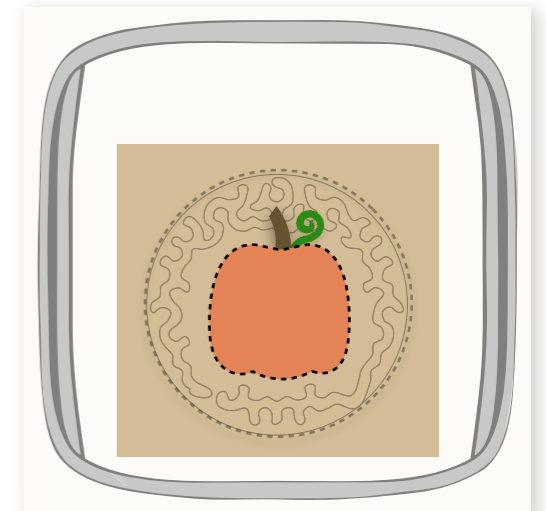
Remove any paper backing from the back of Fabric B, then center the fabric over the placement line. Tape in place, if needed.

Sew **Stitch Sequence 7** to sew a cutting line on Fabric B.



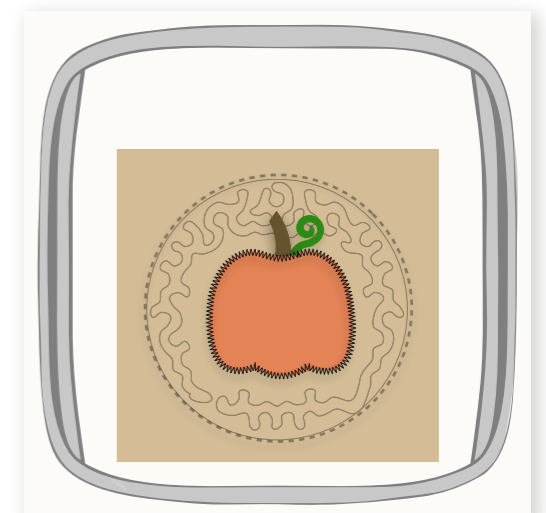
Step 9:

Remove the hoop from the machine and trim around the cutting line, using Pickle Pie Designs Machine Embroidery scissors to get as close as you can to the line of stitches without cutting through them.



Step 10:

Replace the hoop on the machine. Sew **Stitch Sequence 8** to stitch the zigzag stitches around the fabric.



Step 11:

Sew **Stitch Sequence 9** to stitch the satin stitches.



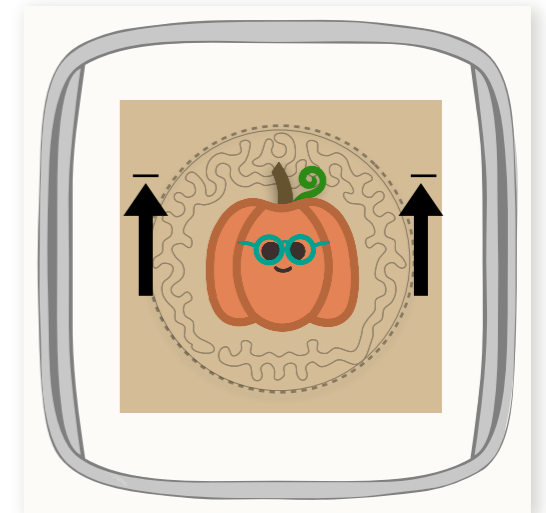
Step 14:

Change to orange thread.

Sew the next stitch sequence to sew placement lines for Fabric C.

Boy version: **Stitch Sequence 12**

Girl version: **Stitch Sequence 11**



Step 12:

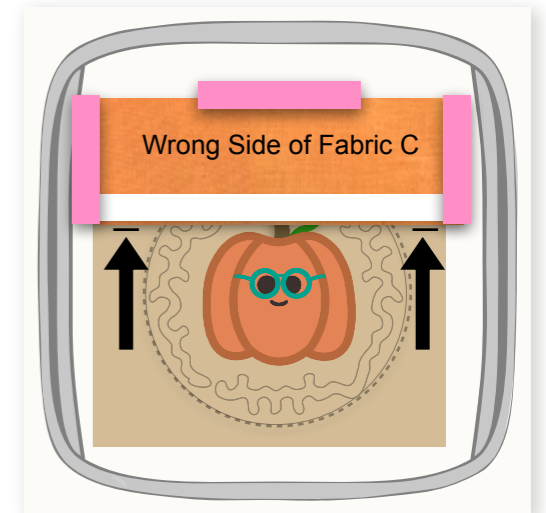
Change to brown thread.

Sew **Stitch Sequence 10** to stitch the eyes and mouth. (The girl version will look different on this step!)



Step 15:

Place Fabric C over the top half of the project, right side down, with the folded edge facing the center of the project. Place the fold across the small Placement Lines on the sides of the project. Tape in place.



Step 13:

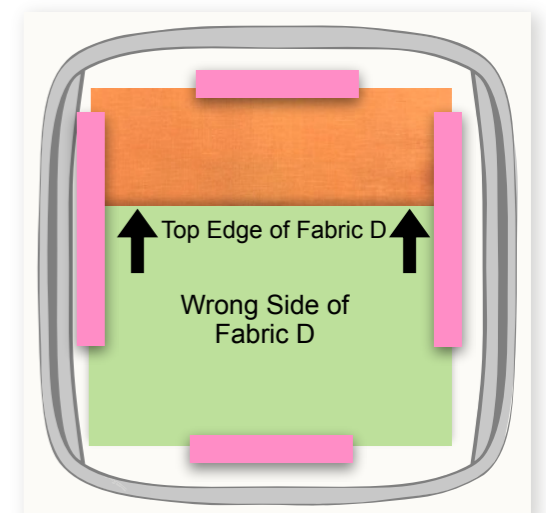
If you are making the girl version, skip to Step 14. Otherwise, change to green thread for the glasses.

Sew **Stitch Sequence 11** to sew the glasses.



Step 16:

Place Fabric D over the bottom half of the project, right side down, overlapping Fabric C by 1/2". Tape in place.



Step 17:

Cover the top edge of Fabric D with Scotch tape (as shown in blue) to prevent the presser foot from getting caught under the edge as it stitches the final outline.

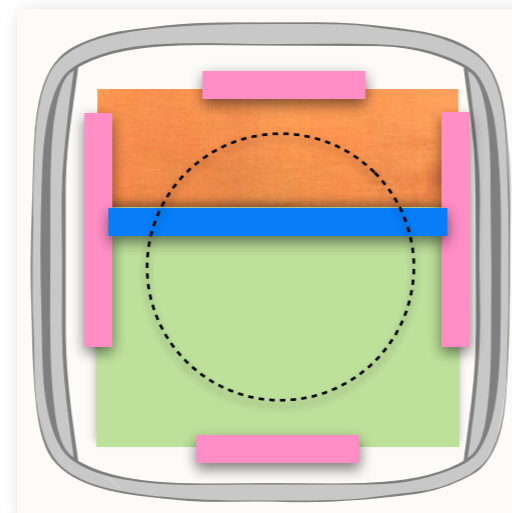


Step 18:

Sew the next stitch sequence to complete the stitching.

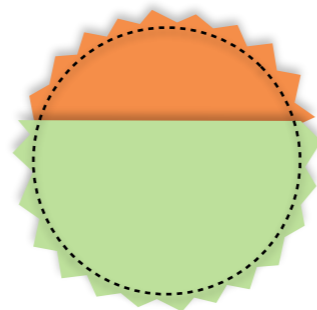
Boy version: **Stitch Sequence 13**

Girl version: **Stitch Sequence 12**



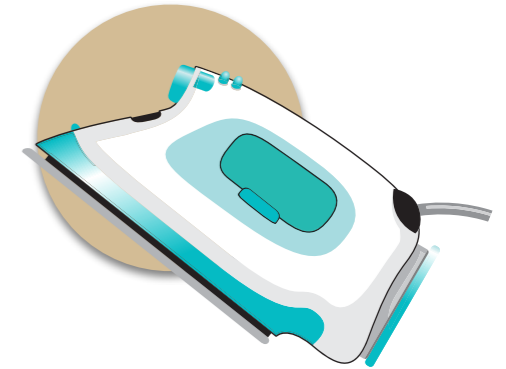
Step 19:

Remove the project from the hoop and remove all tape. Trim around the project, leaving a 1/2" seam allowance. Cut notches into the curves of the seams.



Step 20:

Turn the project right side out through the opening in the back. Smooth out the seams as you go. Remove the paper from the seam tape, then press the back to fuse it closed.
