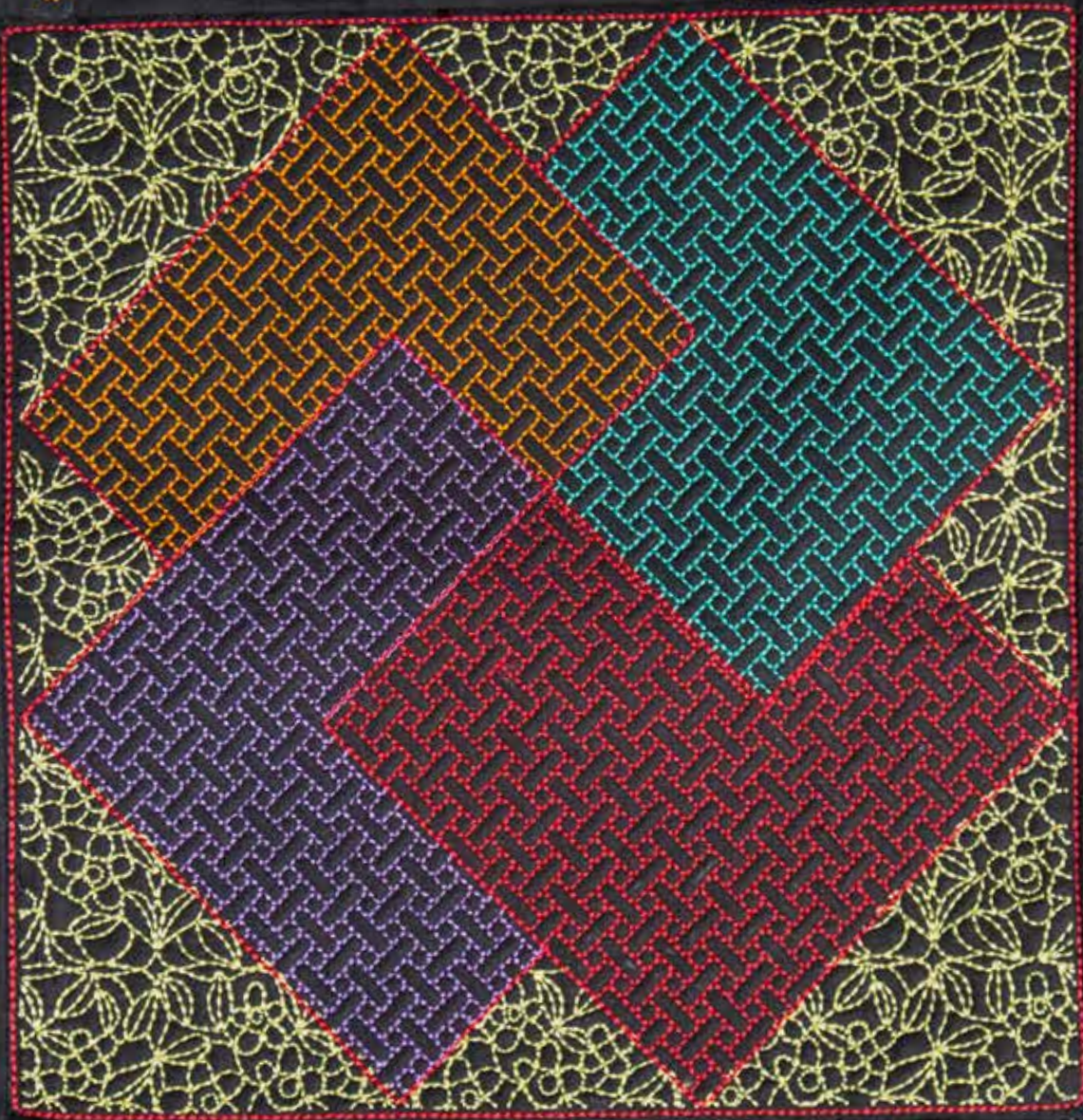

BLOCK 11

Creating Placement Line for Batting:

1. Go to the Settings Page and Change the Largest Hoop with the Cross Hairs

2. Click on IQ Designer 

3. Select the Shapes Icon 



4. Select the Square 

5. Click on Size

6. Change the Size to H = 8.00" and W = 8.00"

7. Click OK

8. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 

9. Click on the Double Run Icon  

10. Click OK

11. Change the Color to Red

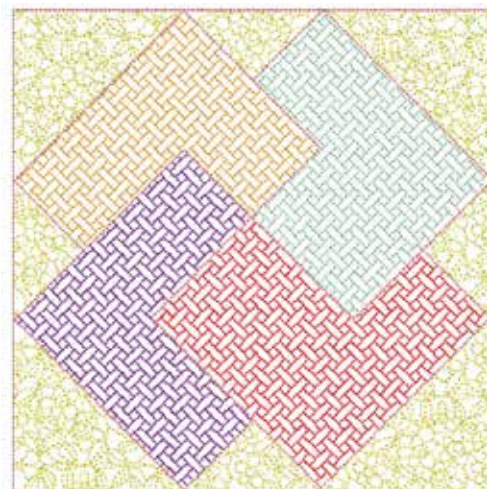
12. Click OK

13. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square

14. Click on the Memory and Save the design to the Machine's Memory

15. Click Next

16. Click Set and OK





Creating Tackdown Line for the Batting:

1. Click Add

2. Click on IQ Designer

3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory

4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 

5. Click on the Double Run Icon  

6. Click OK

7. Change the Color to Green





8. Click OK

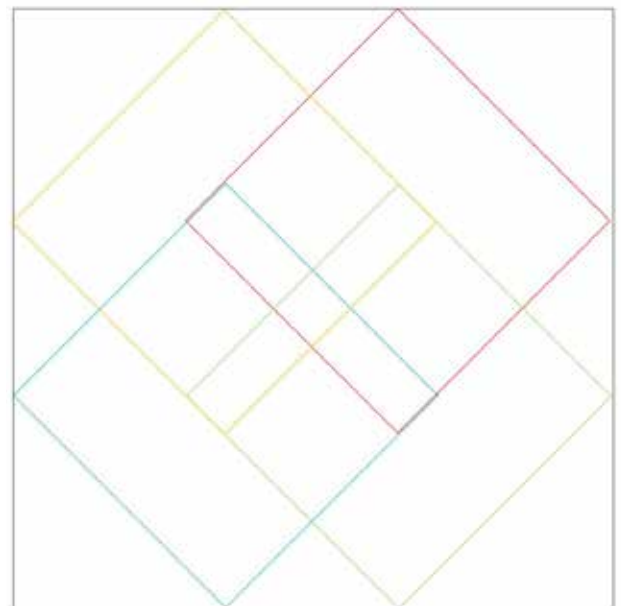
9. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square

10. Click Next

11. Click Set and OK

Creating the Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Click on the Double Run Icon  
6. Click OK
7. Change the Color to Blue
8. Click OK
9. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
10. Click Next
11. Click Set and OK



Creating the Block:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Shapes Icon
5. Select the Square (Column 1 Row 1)
6. Click OK
7. Click on Size
8. Change the Size to 4.00"
9. Click OK
10. Move the Square to the Bottom Right Corner – making sure the small square touches the outside square
11. Click on the Rotate Icon
12. Rotate the Square to 45 Degrees
13. Click on the Duplicate Icon
14. Move the Duplicated Square to the Top Right Side
15. Click Duplicate Again
16. Move the Square to the Top Left Corner
17. Click on the Duplicate Icon one last time
18. Move the Square to the Bottom Left Corner

19. Click on the Memory Icon and Save the Design to the Machine's Memory

20. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



21. Select the Triple Stitch Icon



22. Click OK

23. Change the Color to Red

24. Click OK

25. Click on Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property

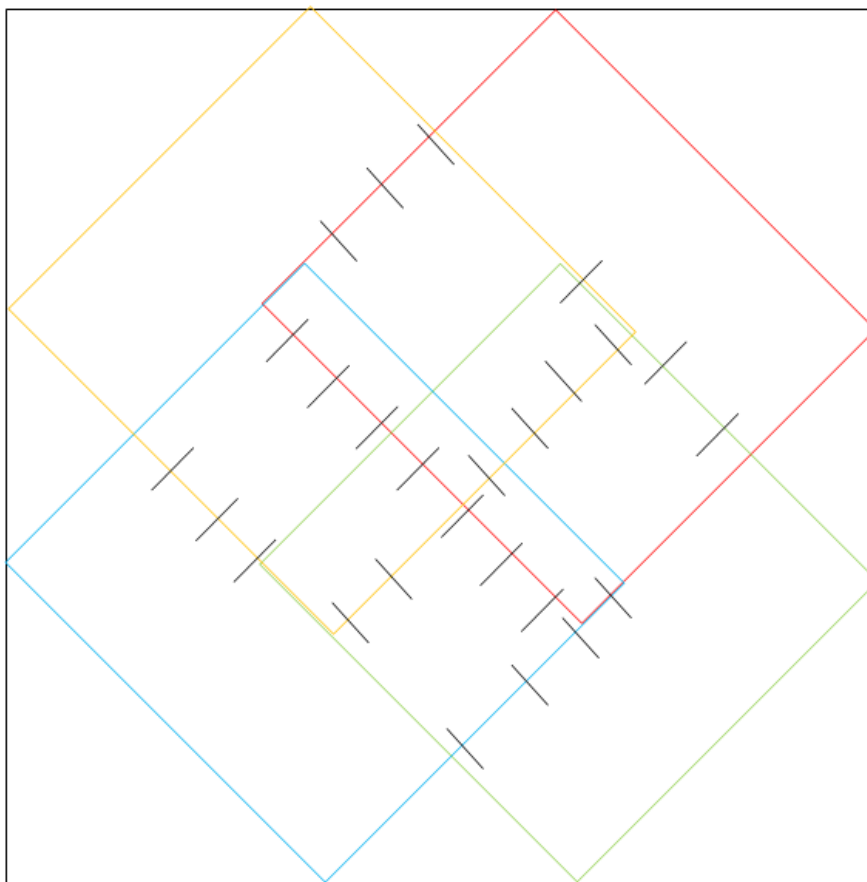


and Touch all the lines

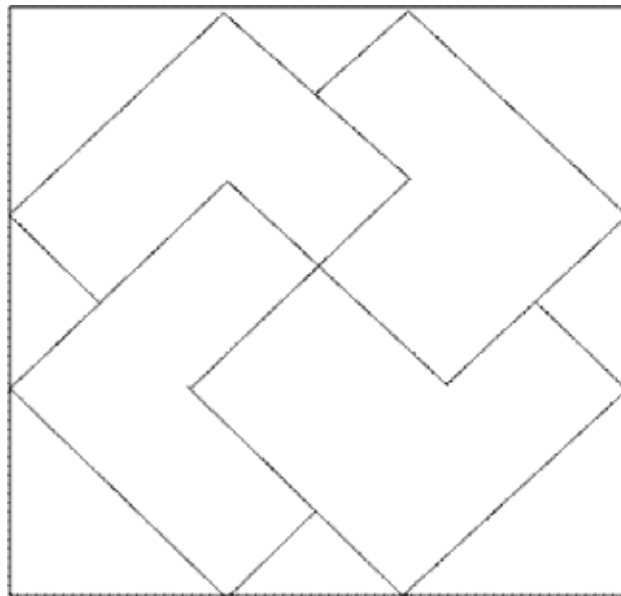
26. Save the design to the Machine's Memory

Filling In Block 11:

1. Before we fill in the areas, we need to delete some excess lines. Refer to the diagram as to which lines need to be deleted. The four squares are represented in different colors in the diagram. The small straight lines are the lines that need to be deleted



2. After the excess lines are deleted, your design should look like the image below



3. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



4. Click on Fancy Fills



5. Click on the word Select



6. Select Fancy Fill #007

7. Click OK

8. Change the Color to Turquoise

9. Click OK

10. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon



Click Inside of the Squares

11. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



12. Click on the word Select



13. Select Fancy Fill #007

14. Click OK

15. Change the Color to Orange

16. Click OK

17. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon



and Click Inside another square

18. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



19. Click on the word Select



20. Select Fancy Fill #007

21. Click OK

22. Change the Color to Purple

23. Click OK

24. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon



and Click another square

25. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



26. Click on the word Select



28. Click OK

29. Change the Color to Red

30. Click OK

31. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon



and Click inside the last square

32. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



33. Click on the word Select



34. Select Fancy Fill #012

35. Click OK

36. Change the Color to Yellow

37. Click OK

38. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property Icon



and Click inside the empty space

39. Click Next

40. Use the Arrow to navigate to the Turquoise

41. Change the Size to 50%

42. Use the Arrow to navigate to the Orange

43. Change the Size to 50%

44. Use the Arrow to navigate to the Purple

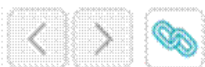
45. Change the Size to 50 %

46. Use the Arrow to navigate to the Red

47. Change the Size to 50 %

48. Use the Arrow to navigate to the Yellow

49. Click on the Link Icon



50. Change the Size to 50 %

51. Click on Set and OK

52. Click on Embroidery

53. Click on the Memory Icon and Save the design to the Machine's Memory

Embroidering Block 11:

1. Hoop a piece of No Show Cutaway Stabilizer in the 9 ½" x 9 ½" Hoop
2. Stitch Out Color 1: Placement Line on top of the stabilizer
3. Lay your Batting on top of the Placement Line.
4. Stitch Out Color 2: Tackdown Stitch for the Batting
5. Remove the Hoop from the machine and trim the batting close to the stitching line
6. Lay the Background Fabric on top of the Batting
7. Stitch Out Color 3: Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric
8. Stitch Out Color 4: Fill #1
9. Stitch Out Color 5: Fill #2
10. Stitch Out Color 6: Fill #3
11. Stitch Out Color 7: Fill #4
12. Stitch Out Color 8: Fill #5
13. Stitch Out Color 9: Entire Block
14. When you are done remove the fabric from the hoop.
15. Cut all around the block, leaving ½ Seam Allowance on all 4 sides of the block
