

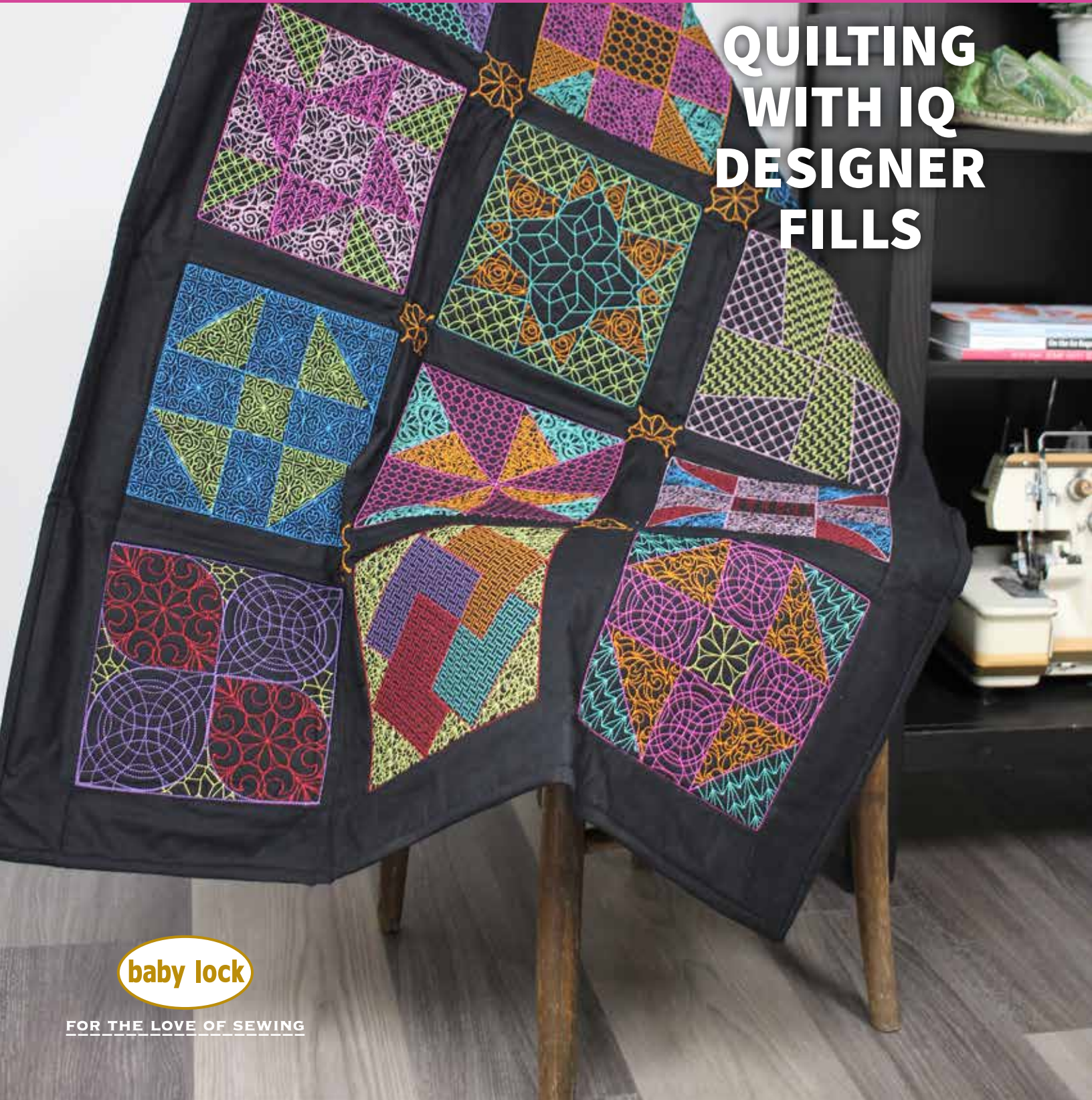

## **Fabric Requirements for the Quilt:**

- Batting 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" – you will need 12 pieces for the entire quilt
- Background 10" x 10" - you will need 12 pieces for the entire quilt
- Backing 1 yard
- Binding 1/3 yard – you will cut it 2 1/2" by WOF
- Horizontal Strips: 2" x 8 1/2" – You will need 9 of these
- Vertical Strips: 2" x 8 – You will need 8 of these
- Borders: 4 Strips 3" by WOF
- Background Fabric for the Small Block –You will need one piece for the 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" hoop

## **Supplies:**

- 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" Hoop
- 13 Pieces of Cut Away Mesh Stabilizer to Fit the 9 1/2" x 9 1/2"
- Embroidery Thread – Variety of Colors
- Bobbin Thread
- Kimberbell's Paper Tape
- Small Embroidery Scissors
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- 1/4" Foot
- Edge Stitch Foot

## **Basic Construction:**

- Once you embroider and trim all the blocks. Attach your 1/4" foot on the machine
- To form one row do the following: Sew Block 1 to a vertical strip to Block 2 to another vertical strip to Block 3
- Press your seams as you go. Repeat for the remaining 3 rows
- Next Sew one horizontal strip to the small block to another horizontal strip to another small block to one more horizontal strip. Press seams as you go. Repeat for the remaining 2 rows.
- Next sew all the rows together
- Now it's time to attach the borders. Attach the two horizontal borders first followed by the two vertical borders
- Lay the backing fabric right side down. Next Lay the batting on top of the backing fabric. Finally lay your quilt on top (you now have a quilt sandwich)
- Use your edge stitch foot and stitch in the ditch
- Trim any excess batting or fabric
- Lastly attach the binding
