FABRIC REQUIREMENTS AND
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric Requirements for the Quilt:

- Batting 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" – you will need 16 pieces for the entire quilt
- Background 10" x 10" - you will need 16 pieces for the entire quilt
- Backing 1 yard
- Binding 1/3 yard – you will cut it 2 1/2" by WOF

In addition you will need:

Corner Block:

- Print Fabric 10" x 10" – you will need 4 pieces. These will be cut on the Diagonal

Flower Block:

- Turquoise Applique Fabric 7" x 7" – you will need 4 pieces
- Blue Applique Fabric – 5" x 5" – you will need 4 pieces

Dresden Block:

- Turquoise Applique Fabric 5" x 7" – you will need 4 pieces
- Blue Applique Fabric – 5" x 7" – you will need 4 pieces
- Orange Applique Fabric – 5" x 7" – you will need 8 pieces

Supplies:

- 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" Hoop
- 16 Pieces of Cut Away Mesh Stabilizer to Fit the 9 1/2" x 9 1/2"
- Embroidery Thread – Variety of Colors
- White Bobbin Thread
- Kimberbell's Paper Tape
- Small Embroidery Scissors
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- 1/4" Foot
- Edge Stitch Foot



Basic Construction:

- Once you embroider and trim all the blocks. Attach your ¼" foot on the machine
- Join the individual blocks together to form a row. Press your seams as you go
- Once you have 4 rows, sew them together to form the top of the quilt
- Lay the backing fabric right side down. Next Lay the batting on top of the backing fabric. Finally lay your quilt on top (you now have a quilt sandwich)
- Use your edge stitch foot and stitch in the ditch
- Trim any excess batting or fabric
- Lastly attach the binding
