

SEWING MENDS YOUR SOUL MUG RUGS/WALL HANGINGS



Create these simple Mug Rugs/Wall Hangings completely in-the-hoop – no hand sewing required.

I created these designs specifically for Mug Rugs, but as I was testing them, I decided they make very cute small Wall Hangings, plus the designs by themselves were really nice on Towels - perfect as gifts (or swaps) for your sewing friends.

- The set includes:
- Mug Rug designs as pictured 5X7 hoop
 - 'Plain' designs with pretty chain stitch frame (for Towels) 5X7 hoop
 - The individual elements for 4x4 hoops

Mug Rug/Wall Hanging Finished size - just under 5x7 inch

MATERIALS TO MAKE COASTERS

- Tear- away Stabiliser to fit hoop
- Ribbon (If making a Wall Hanging)

Inner Fabric	5x7 inch
Pellon/Batting	6x8 inch
Outer Fabric	6x8 inch
Backing Fabric	Two 7x6 inch panels



Load design to your machine

Hoop Tear-away Stabiliser

Thread machine with the color you will be using for the quilting – we used white

Stitch Color 1 which is a guideline for placing your Outer block fabric and pella

Place your pella and Outer fabric piece over the Guideline



Stitch Color 2 which attaches the fabric and pella and stitches a guideline for your Inner Fabric



Place your Inner Block Fabric over the Guideline

Stitch Color 3

Remove hoop from machine, and cut away the excess Inner Black Fabric



Complete your chosen embroidery design

Color 8	Rest of words

CLEAN HOUSE MUG RUG



Color 7	Words – CLEAN HOUSE and BROKEN
Color 8	Picture
Color 9	Rest of words

FULL BOBBIN MUG RUG



Color 7	Frame around picture
Color 8	Picture
Color 9	Words – MAY YOUR
Color 10	Word - BOBBIN
Color 11	Words - ALWAYS BE FULL

MENDS YOUR SOUL MUG RUG



Color 7	Frame around picture
Color 8	Picture
Color 9	Words – SEWING and SOUL
Color 10	Word – MENDS YOUR

A STITCH IN TIME MUG RUG



Color 7	Frame around picture
Color 8	Picture
Color 9	Words – A and SAVES NINE
Color 10	Word – STITCH IN TIME

To complete Mug Rugs/Wall Hanging



If you want to make your Mug Rug into a Wall Hanging, you need to add your hanger now.

Place your ribbon as pictured, taping the edges outside of the stitching line.

Fold your two backing pieces in half and press



As pictured, place your two folded pieces of backing fabric with folded edges towards middle and over lapping by about 2cm

Stitch last Color which stitches it all together

Remove from hoop and cutaway the excess stabiliser/pellon and fabric

Turn to right-side
